ISTANBUL - The joy of art, entertainment and hopping... We've all heard the descriptions of Istanbul being a bridge between Europe and Asia, a place where East meets West and where cultures have happily coexisted for centuries. But not everyone is aware of its extraordinary contrasts and endlessly fascinating contradictions.

Hittites, Byzantines, and early Christians established important landmarks here, as did Mother Nature with her stunning erosion of the soft volcanic deposits creating dramatic cliffs, valleys, cones, and “fairy chimneys”.

Cappadocia generously spreads out before visitors. An extraordinary and lavish banquet of natural wonders exceeding their wildest imagination and elegantly graced with works by the hand of man.



BODRUM – The Land of Eternal Blue offers a great blend of lively beach resorts, places of historical interest and never ending fun & entertainment

Bodrum is established upon one of the antique cities of great known “Halicarnassos”. The artifacts in the Bodrum Museum prove to us that this city and its surroundings can boast a civilization of aprox. 5000 years.

EPHESUS - A unique experience; feeling like an Ancient Roman, walking in marble streets of 2000 years ago's glorious city Ephesus. The well-preserved ruins of the ancient city lie near the western shores of modern-day Turkey.

Considered as one of the most precious ancient sites, Ephesus' ruins tell the story of the once most important ancient Greek city and trading center in the Mediterranean region.

Ancient Ephesian treasures like the remains of the giant Temple of Artemis, the Library of Celsus, a gigantic 25,000 seat amphitheater, and the well-preserved Hadrian Temple all reveal a city of grand historical, cultural, and architectural significance.



PAMUKKALE- With its healing springs, Turkey's 'white paradise' feels more like something out of a fairy tale. It offers natural wellness and treatment opportunities that have been celebrated over centuries.

Deriving from springs in a cliff overlooking the plain of south-western Turkey, calcite-laden waters have created an unreal landscape, made up of mineral forests, petrified waterfalls, and a series of terraced basins given the name of Pamukkale (Cotton Palace).

Located in the province of Denizli, this extraordinary landscape was a focus of interest for visitors to the nearby Hellenistic spa town of Hierapolis, founded by the Attalid kings of Pergamon at the end of the 2nd century B.C., at the site of an ancient cult.

Today, with the remains of the Greco-Roman period include baths, temple ruins, a monumental arch, a nymphaeum, a necropolis, and a theatre, Hierapolis is one of the –worth to see open-air museums of Turkey.
