Known as the UAE garden city, thanks to its lush setting in the heart of a sandy landscape, Al Ain overflows with visual charm




Adventure Experience Package (Summer Season)

Al Jahili Fort





Al Jahili Fort, one of the largest forts in the United Arab Emirates, was built in the late 19th century by Sheikh Zayed bin Khalifa (Zayed the great) (r. 1855-1909), both as a symbol of power and as a royal summer residence. The original fort consisted of a square fortified enclosure and a distinctive four-storey circular tower.

1985, early restoration work was done on the fort, while in 2007-2008, the fort underwent a major rehabilitation project. A visitor information centre, permanent exhibition space devoted to the explorer and photograph Wilfred Thesiger, and a temporary exhibition space were added. Visitors will enjoy a set of activities and performances that highlight the spirit of this important cultural site through a set of programs, cultural and educational workshops and events that target all visitors from different cultures.

Al Ain Palace Museum





Al Ain Palace was one of the Al Ain residences of the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, the founding father and first President of the United Arab Emirates. He lived there with his family until 1966 when he moved to Abu Dhabi city as the new ruler of the emirate. The Palace provides a glimpse into the life of the ruling family and the culture of the local community before the unification of the country.

Al Ain Palace is significant for its major role in the life and story of Sheikh Zayed during his twenty years as Ruler's Representative in the Eastern Region of Abu Dhabi Emirate. It stands witness to the great transformations that Al Ain went through from the middle of the last century and contains elements of the city's traditional architecture. Visitors to the museum will enjoy interactive activities and performances that highlight the spirit of this important cultural site through a set of programs, cultural and educational workshops and events that target all visitors from different cultures.

Al Ain Oasis is the largest oasis in Al Ain. Al Ain Oasis is a part of an assemblage of 6 oases in Al Ain City that are Clusters sites of the Property of the Cultural Sites of Al Ain that have been granted World Heritage Status by UNESCO in 2011 for unique preservation of a way of life that has existed from ancient times until today. The Oasis is spread over 1,200 hectares and contains more than 147,000 date palms of different varieties. The Oasis is bordered by Al Ain National Museum to the East, the Al Ain Palace Museum to the West and the Naqfa Ridge to the South. All the plantations in the oasis are walled off and irrigated by an old 'falaj' irrigation system of narrow waterways which is in use in Al Ain since 3,000 years. The water comes from the mountains about 15 kilometers away. Visitors to the Alain oasis will enjoy interactive activities and performances that highlight the spirit of this important cultural site. Through a set of programs, cultural and educational workshops and events that target all visitors from different cultures.



Hili Archaeological Park was developed to highlight the ancient monuments of Al Ain and make them easily accessible to visitors. The site not only provides the earliest known evidence of an agricultural village in the United Arab Emirates but also contains other Bronze Age and Iron Age villages, burial grounds, towers and agricultural infrastructure. The early agricultural village is located at Hili 8 Site and dates to 3000 BCE.

The park's centrepiece is the Hili Grand Tomb, dating to about 2000 BCE. Built in a circular form with a diameter of up to 12 metres, and approximately 4 metres high, the tomb was used to bury people from surrounding settlements. The tomb has two entrances decorated with beautifully engraved reliefs portraying human and animal figurines. Many other similar tombs can be found throughout the area of Hili, with an archaeological trail being planned to permit tourists to visit these sites and learn more about the Umm an-Nar culture up close.

There are other archaeological structures around the park, but it is chiefly a garden with plants, fountains and a small children's play area.

In line with the vision of the UAE's founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, Al Ain Safari plays a prominent role in conservation, setting a benchmark for future conservation projects in the region. Wadi Adventure is a fantastic family-friendly adventure park that sits at the base of the majestic and history-rich Jebel Hafit mountain, Abu Dhabi's tallest peak, about an hour and a half away from the city in Al Ain

Home to the Middle East's first man-made white water rafting channels, measuring 1,100 metres in length and perfect for rafting and kayaking, Wadi Adventure also has a surfing wall, wakeboarding facilities, swimming pool and splash pool. Action fans will love the park's exhilarating aerial adventure course that includes an 18-obstacle, two-level airpark, 1,200-metre long zip line, vertical climb line and 14-metre high giant swing.

This venue is also a great option for team building and corporate events, with the Summit Events Centre providing a versatile space for meetings and even birthday parties. Sports professionals from around the world regularly visit the park, which also provides training programmes and complete packages including accommodation and airport transfers.




