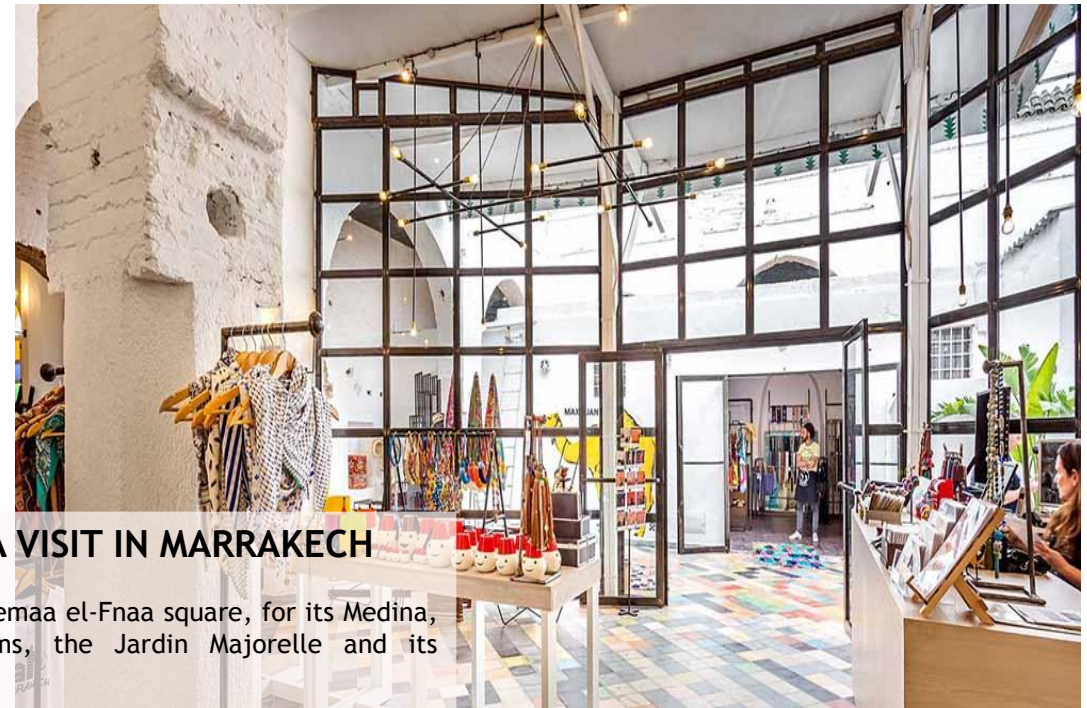

STORES WORTH A VISIT IN MARRAKECH

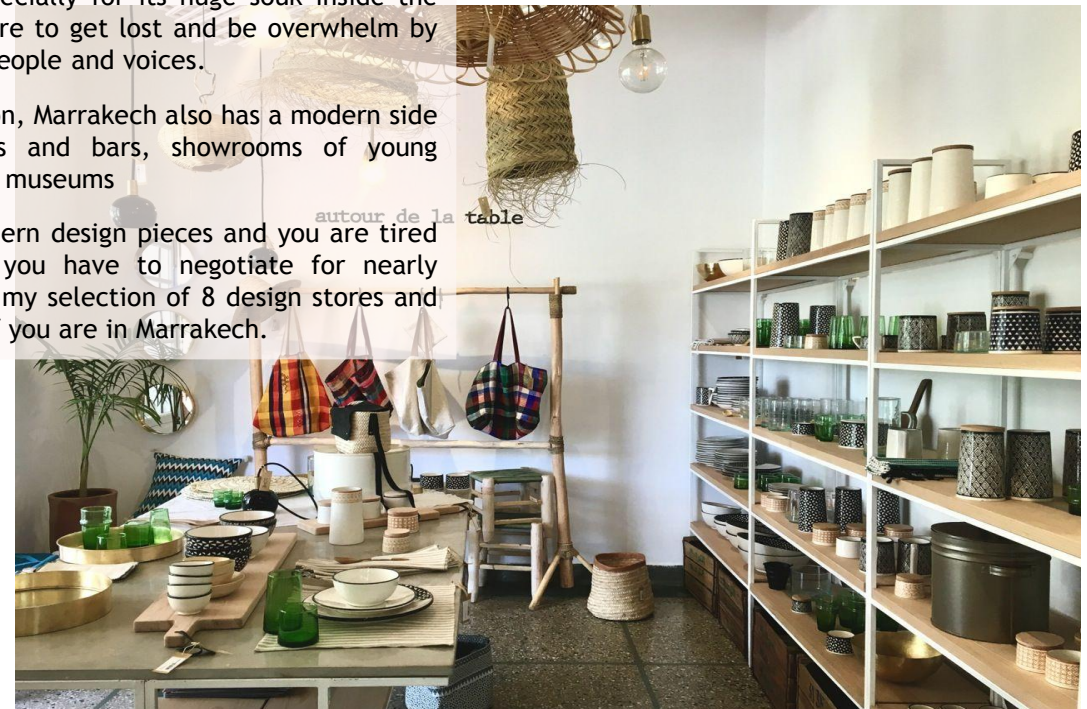
Marrakech is known for the Jemaa el-Fnaa square, for its Medina, for the riads and hammams, the Jardin Majorelle and its atmosphere.

But together with the tradition, Marrakech also has a modern side made of trendy restaurants and bars, showrooms of young designers, boutiques and new museums

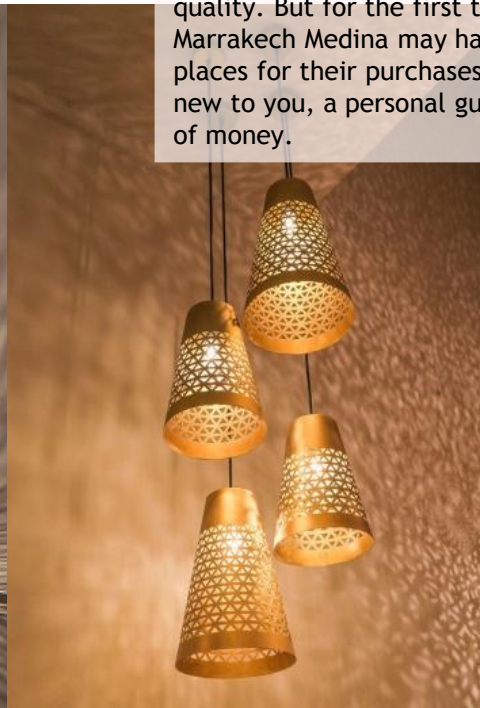

PRIVATE SHOPPING WITH GUIDE

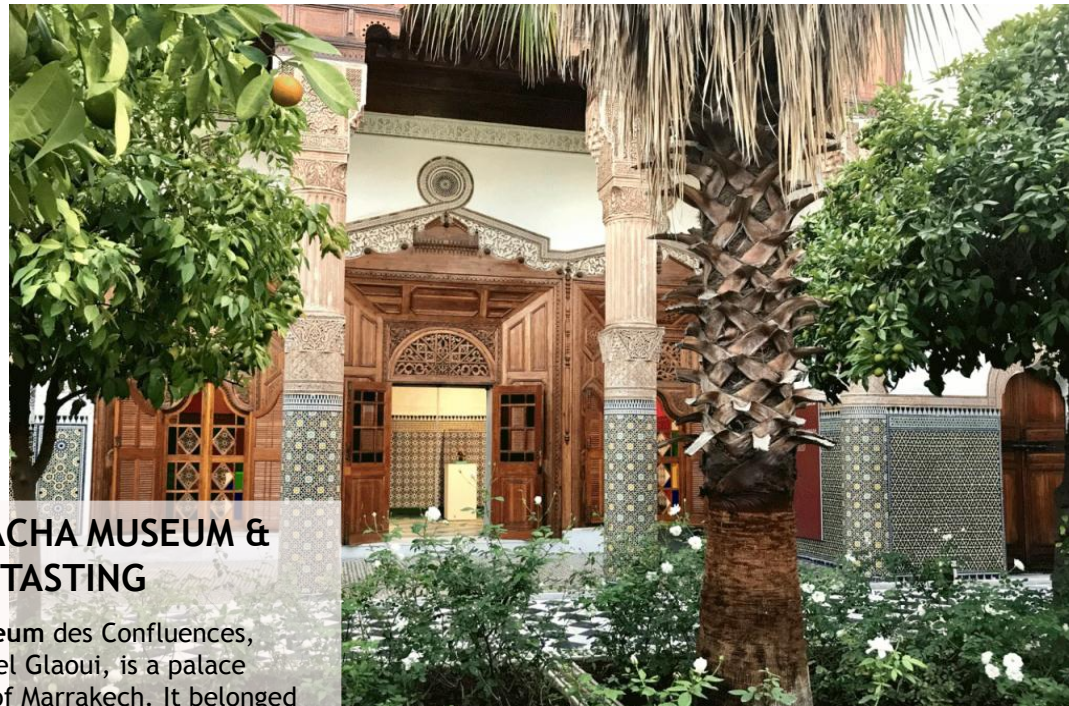

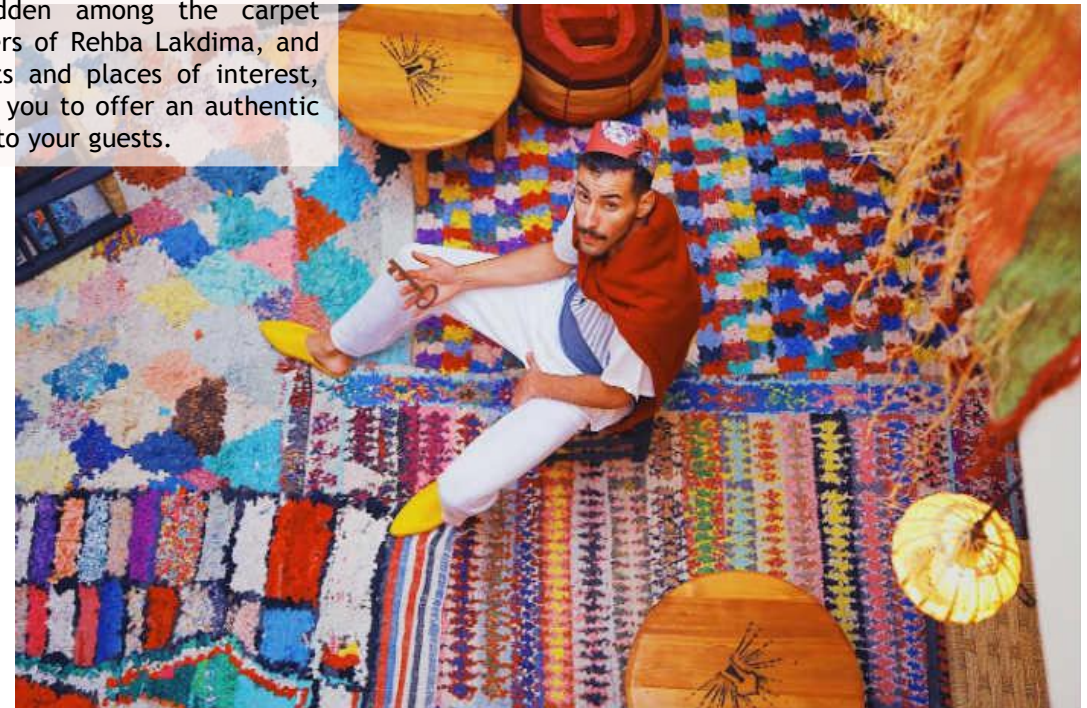
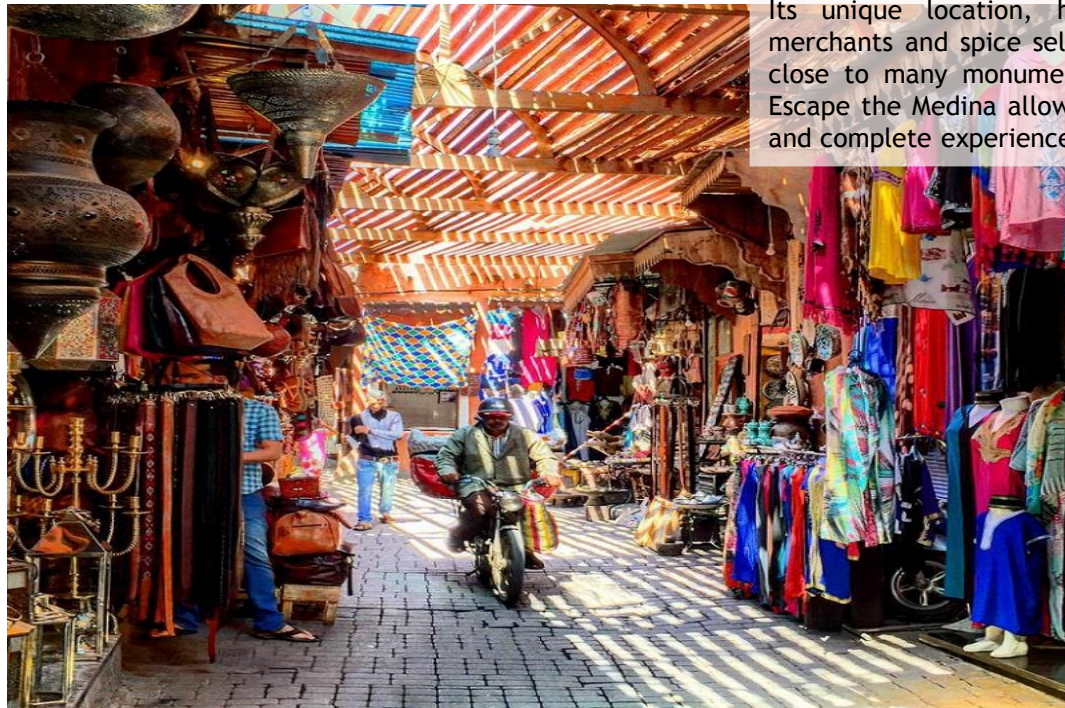




ESCAPE THE MEDINA

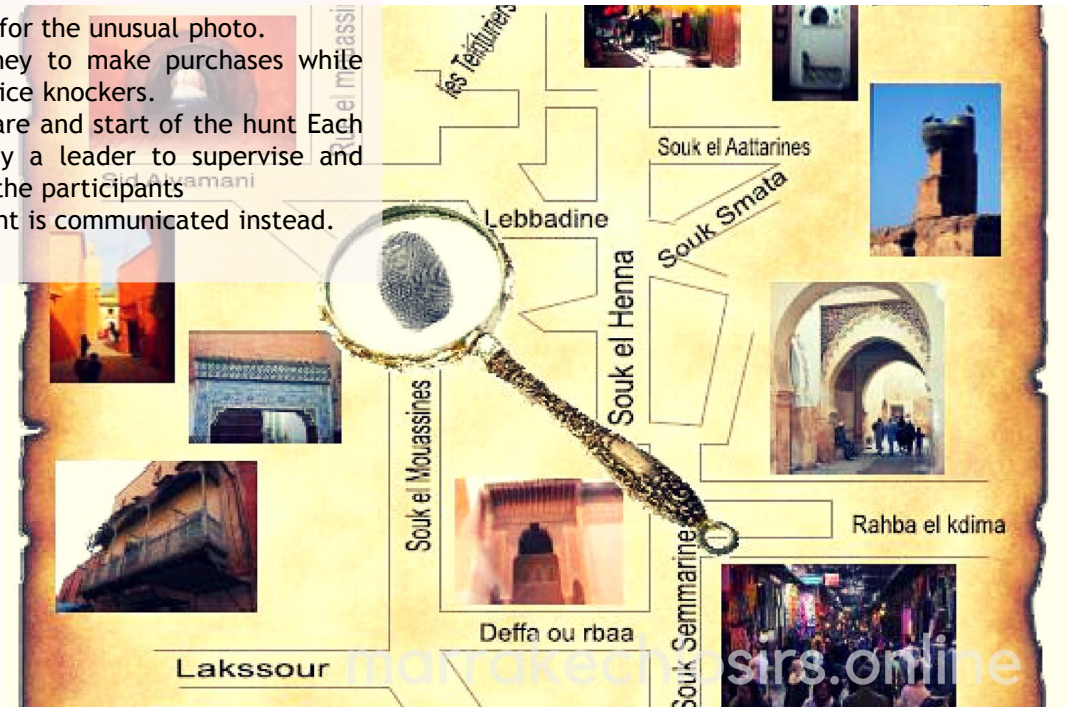




TREASURE HUNT IN THE MEDINA

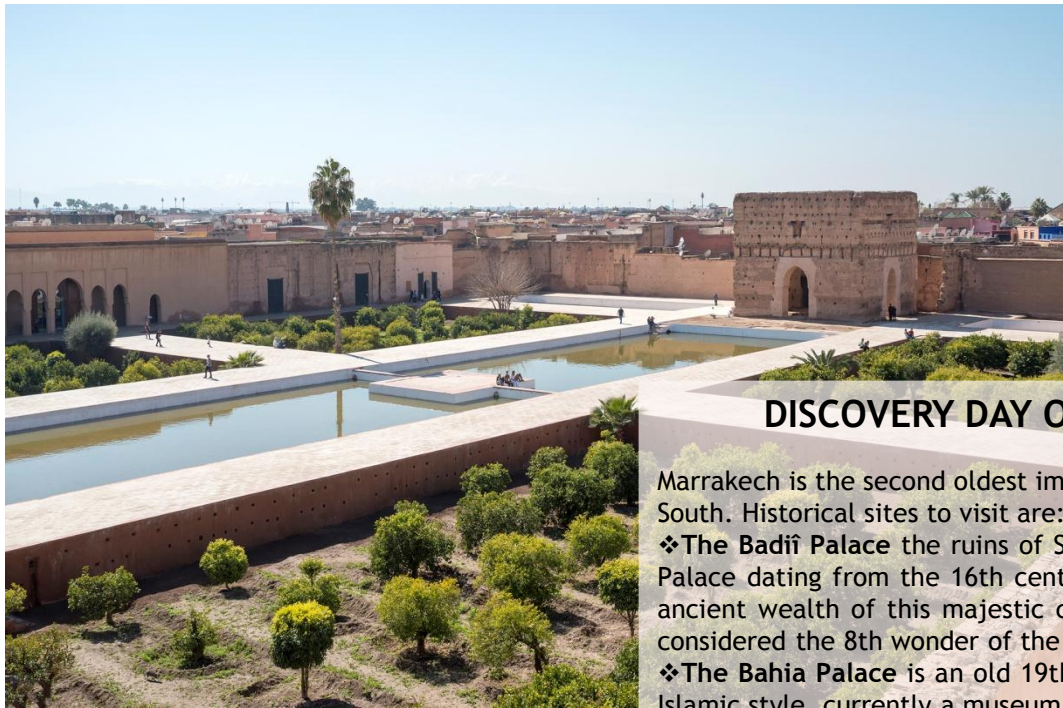
Program:

DISCOVERY DAY OF MARRAKECH CITY

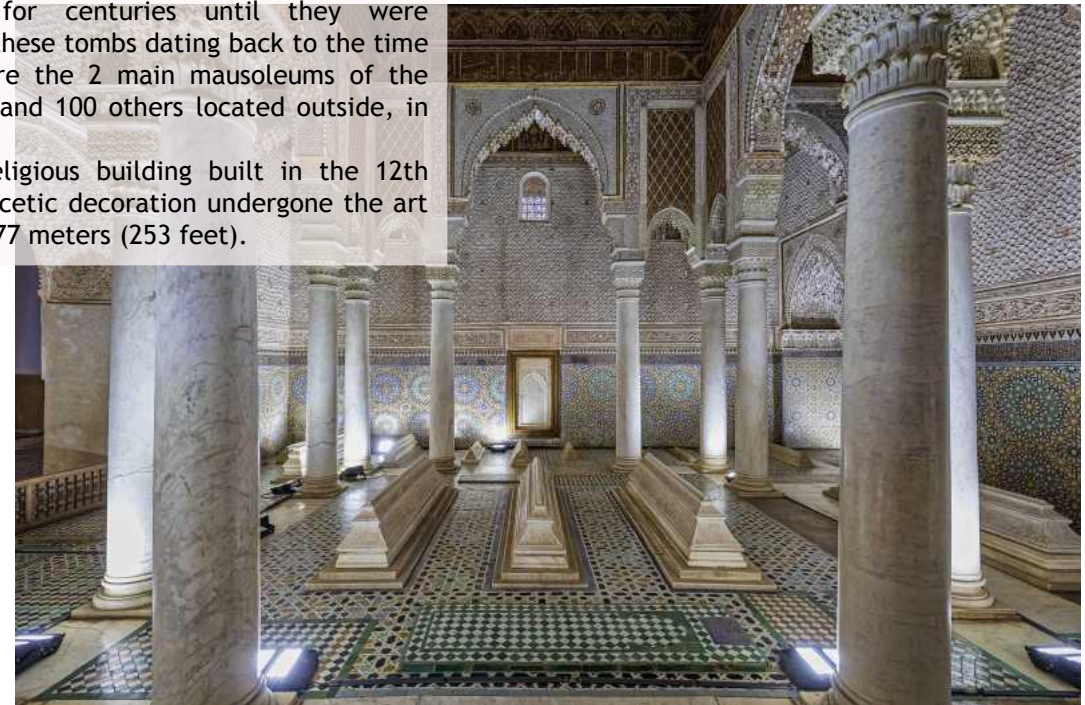
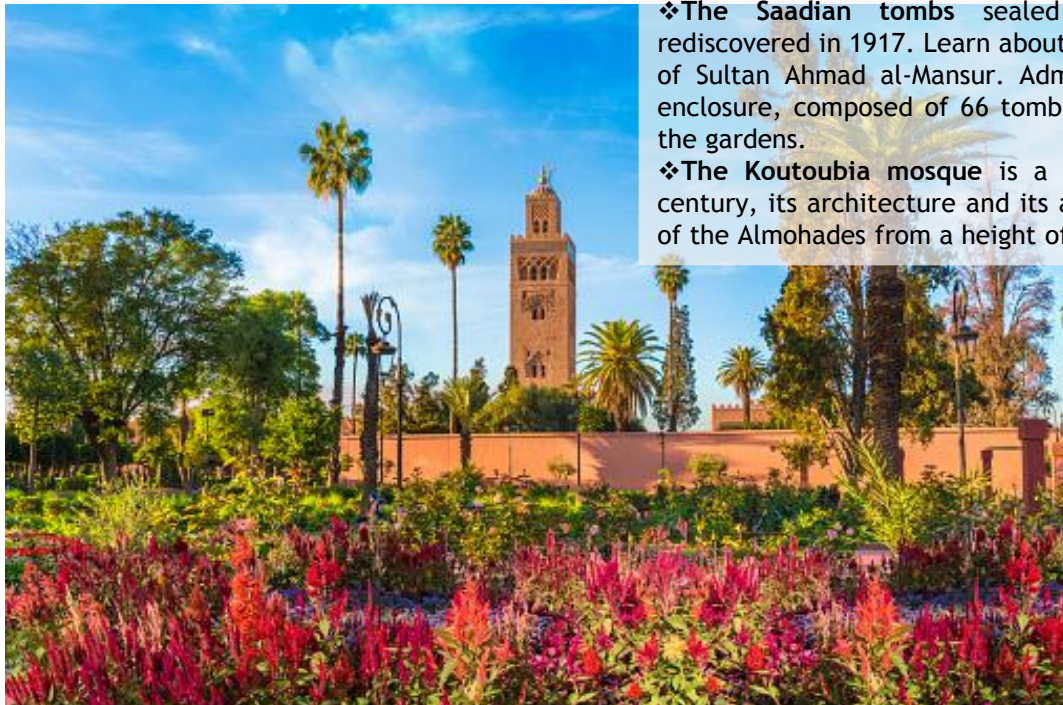
Marrakech is the second oldest imperial city, known as the Pearl of the South. Historical sites to visit are:

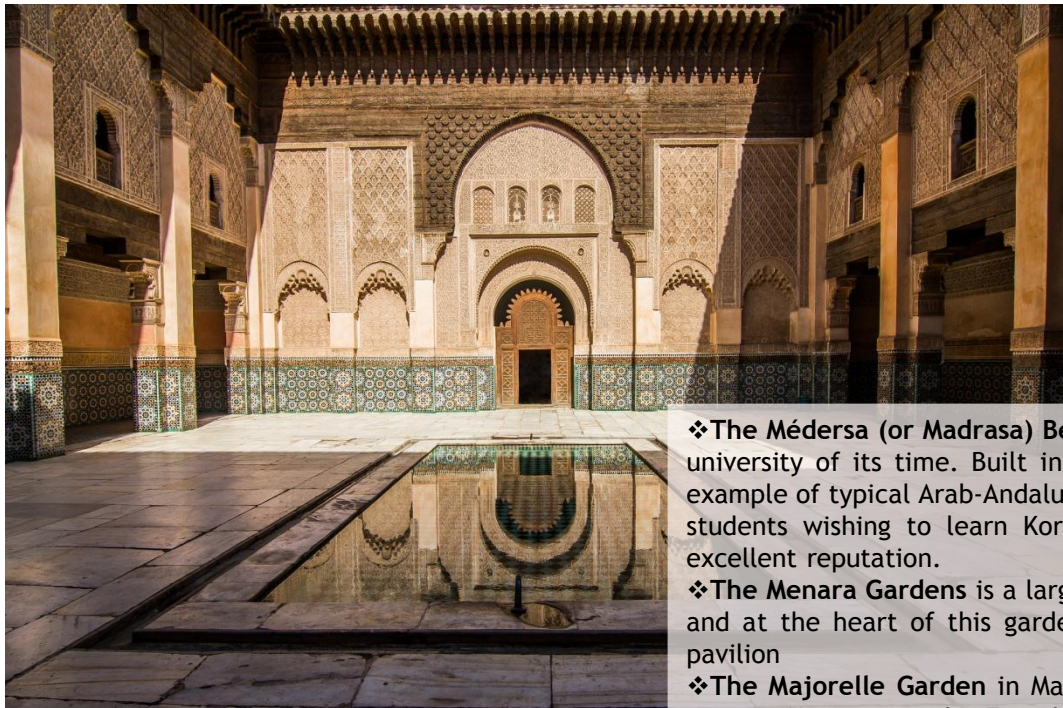
- ❖ **The Badii Palace** the ruins of Sultan Ahmed El Mansour's grand Badi Palace dating from the 16th century. You will enjoy a glimpse of the ancient wealth of this majestic city. Learn why the palace was once considered the 8th wonder of the world.

- ❖ **The Bahia Palace** is an old 19th century palace of eight hectares in Islamic style. currently a museum.

- ❖ **The Saadian tombs** sealed for centuries until they were rediscovered in 1917. Learn about these tombs dating back to the time of Sultan Ahmad al-Mansur. Admire the 2 main mausoleums of the enclosure, composed of 66 tombs and 100 others located outside, in the gardens.

- ❖ **The Koutoubia mosque** is a religious building built in the 12th century, its architecture and its ascetic decoration undergone the art of the Almohades from a height of 77 meters (253 feet).





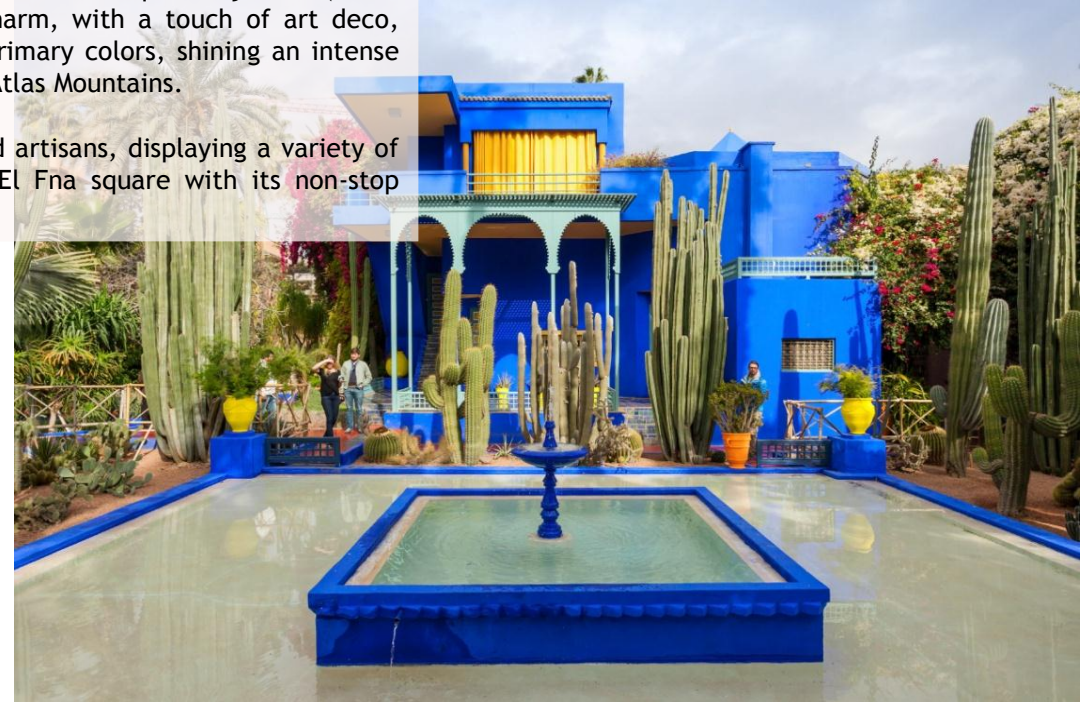
❖ **The Médersa (or Madrasa) Ben Youssef** was the largest Koranic university of its time. Built in the 16th century, it is a perfect example of typical Arab-Andalusian architecture. It still welcomes students wishing to learn Koranic theology and still enjoys an excellent reputation.

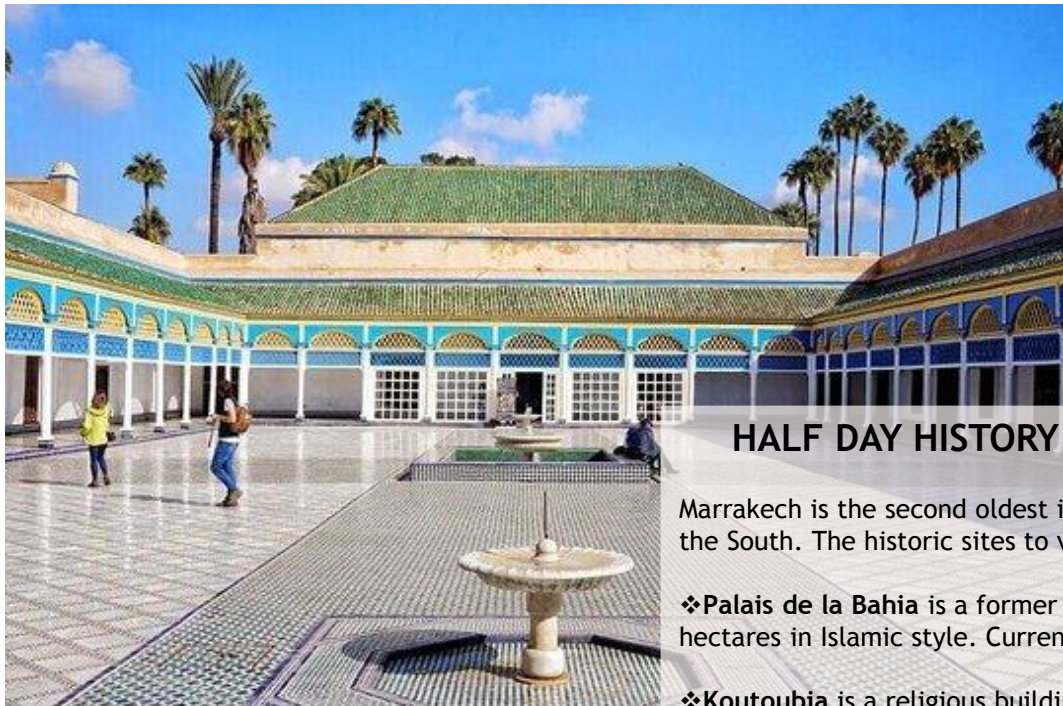
❖ **The Menara Gardens** is a large garden planted with olive trees, and at the heart of this garden, a large pond at the foot of a pavilion

❖ **The Majorelle Garden** in Marrakech is one of the most visited sites in Morocco to the French painter Jacques Majorelle (1886-1962) A building with Moorish charm, with a touch of art deco, painted in surprisingly vibrant primary colors, shining an intense blue the artist perceived in the Atlas Mountains.

❖ Lunch at local restaurant.

❖ Afternoon, visit **The Souks** and artisans, displaying a variety of items and the famous Djemaa El Fna square with its non-stop entertainment.





HALF DAY HISTORY VISIT OF MARRAKECH

Marrakech is the second oldest imperial city, known as the Pearl of the South. The historic sites to visit with a professional guide are:

- ❖ **Palais de la Bahia** is a former nineteenth century palace of eight hectares in Islamic style. Currently a museum.

- ❖ **Koutoubia** is a religious building built in the 12th century, its architecture and ascetic decor reflect the art of the Almohads from a height of 77 meters (253 feet).

- ❖ Visit **The Souks** and artisans, presenting a variety of items and the famous **Djemaa El Fna** square with its non-stop entertainment.

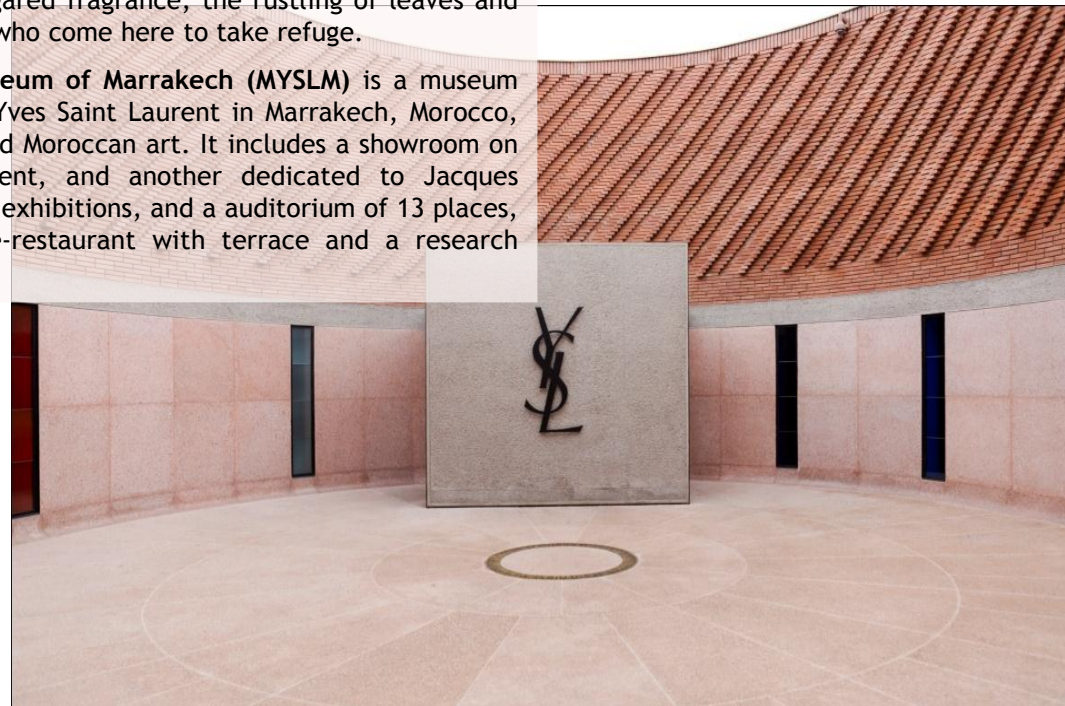
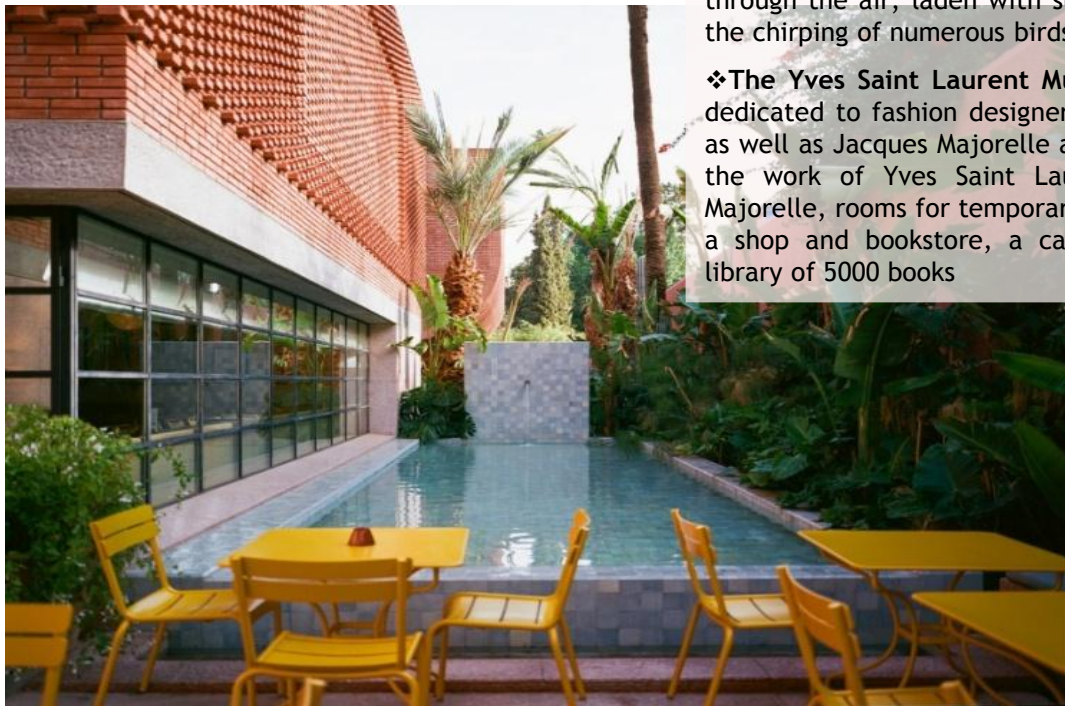




HALF DAY VISIT MAJORELLE GARDEN & YVES SAINT LAURENT MUSEUM

❖The Majorelle Garden in Marrakech is one of the most visited sites in Morocco. It took French painter Jacques Majorelle (1886-1962) forty years of passion and dedication to create this enchanting garden in the heart of the “Ochre City”. We amble along shady lanes, in the midst of trees and exotic plants of dreamy origin; we walk past refreshing, burbling streams and pools filled with water lilies and lotus flowers; we hear wafting through the air, laden with sugared fragrance, the rustling of leaves and the chirping of numerous birds who come here to take refuge.

❖The Yves Saint Laurent Museum of Marrakech (MYSLM) is a museum dedicated to fashion designer Yves Saint Laurent in Marrakech, Morocco, as well as Jacques Majorelle and Moroccan art. It includes a showroom on the work of Yves Saint Laurent, and another dedicated to Jacques Majorelle, rooms for temporary exhibitions, and a auditorium of 13 places, a shop and bookstore, a café-restaurant with terrace and a research library of 5000 books



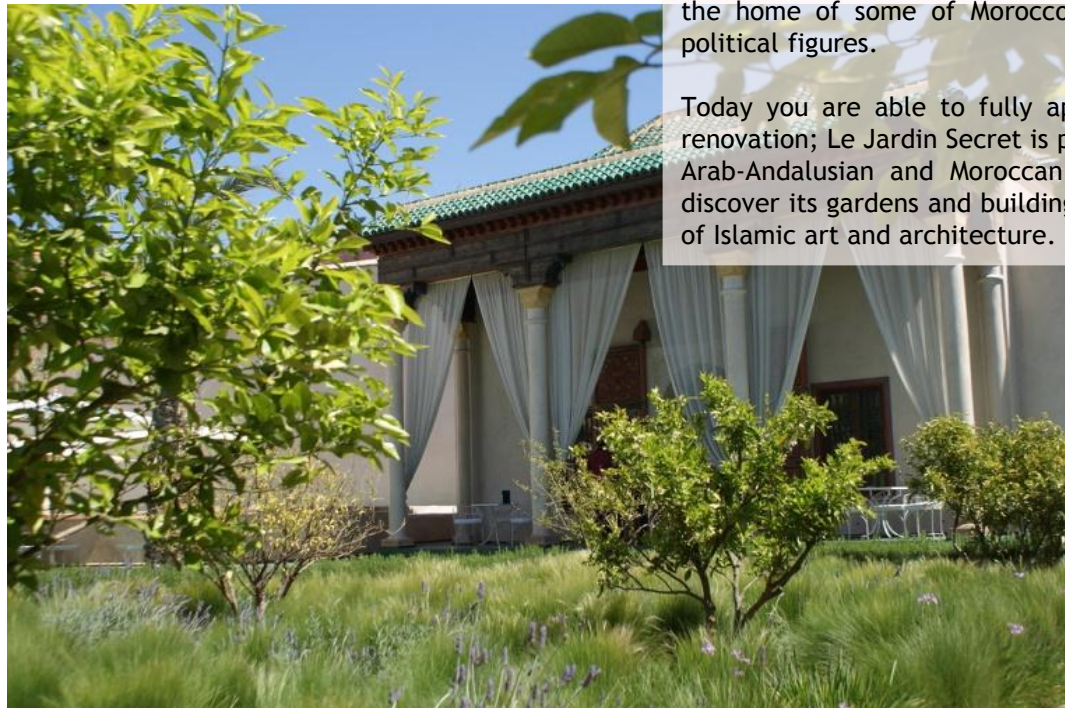


VISIT THE SECRET GARDEN

Le Jardin Secret is opening its doors to the public for the first time in its history. The origins of the complex date back to the Saadian Dynasty, more than four hundred years ago.

Rebuilt in the mid-Nineteenth century at the behest of an influential Kaid of the Atlas Mountains, Le Jardin Secret has been the home of some of Morocco and Marrakech's most important political figures.

Today you are able to fully appreciate it, thanks to the recent renovation; Le Jardin Secret is part of the great tradition of stately Arab-Andalusian and Moroccan palaces. As a result visitors can discover its gardens and buildings, which are outstanding examples of Islamic art and architecture.

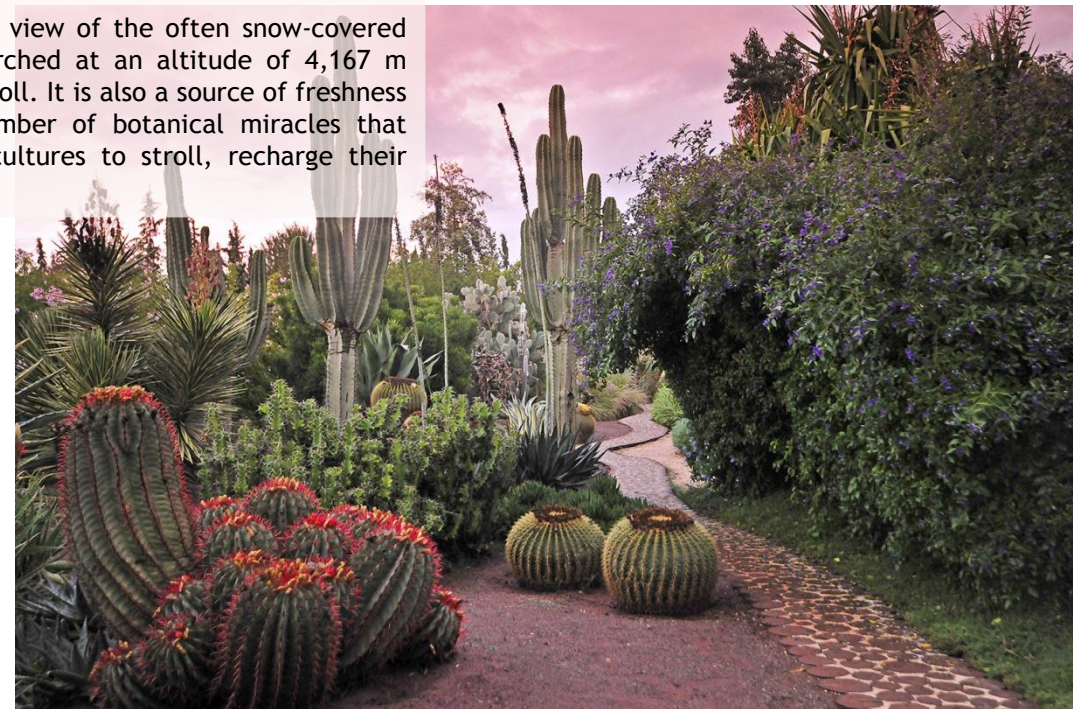




VISIT THE ANIMA GARDEN

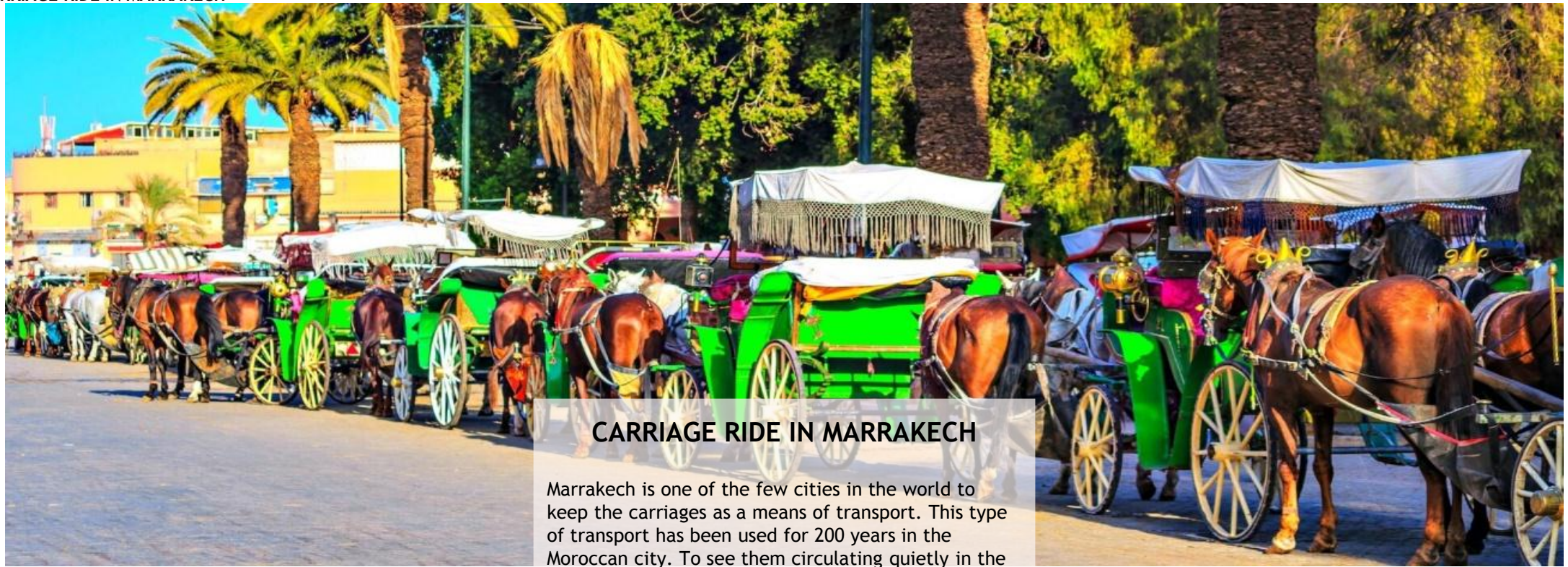

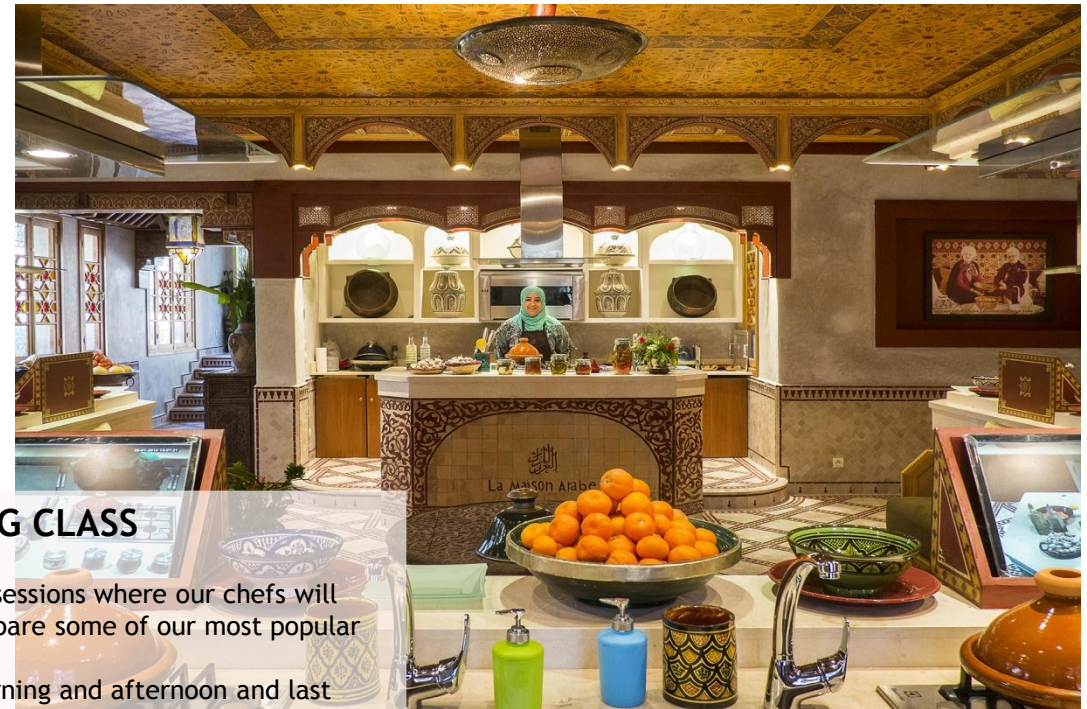
COOKING CLASS

It is the friendly space for your getaways, integration days, Team Building, strategy and team spirit are the keys to a game of paintball or in the end fun and good humor l prevail.

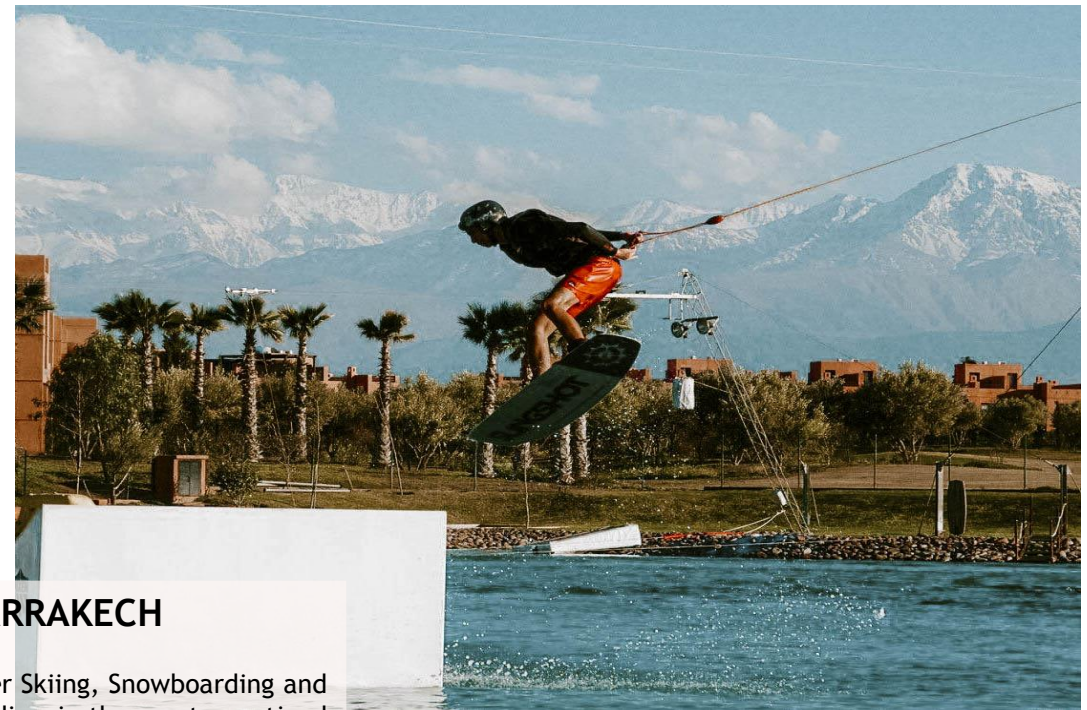




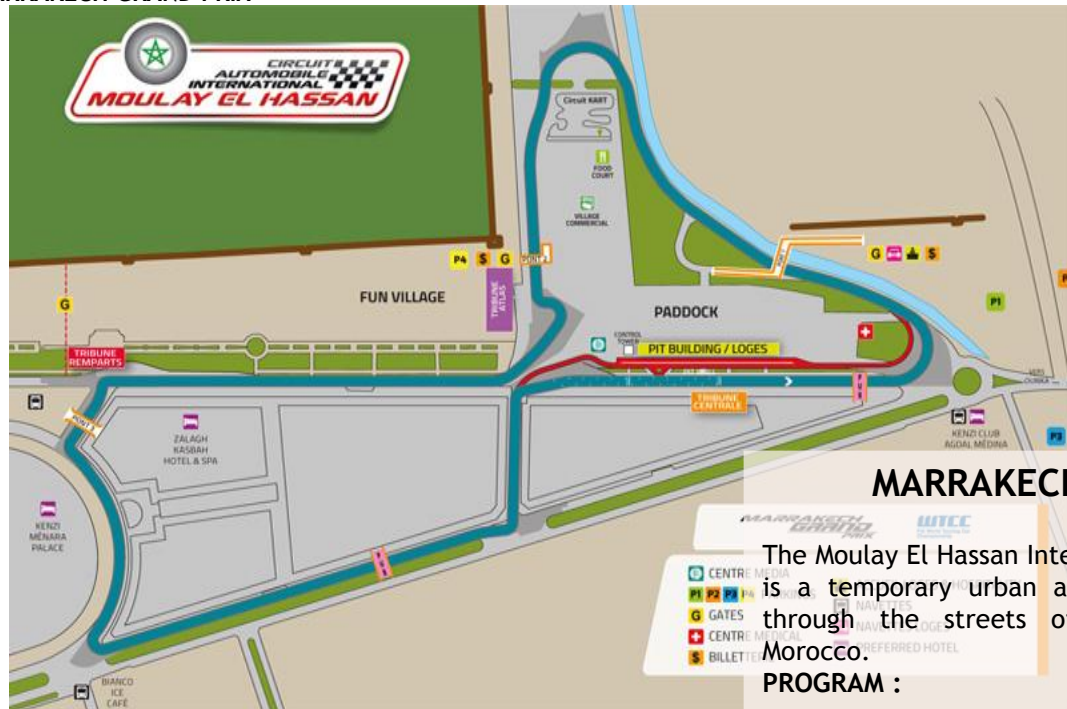
WAKY MARRAKECH

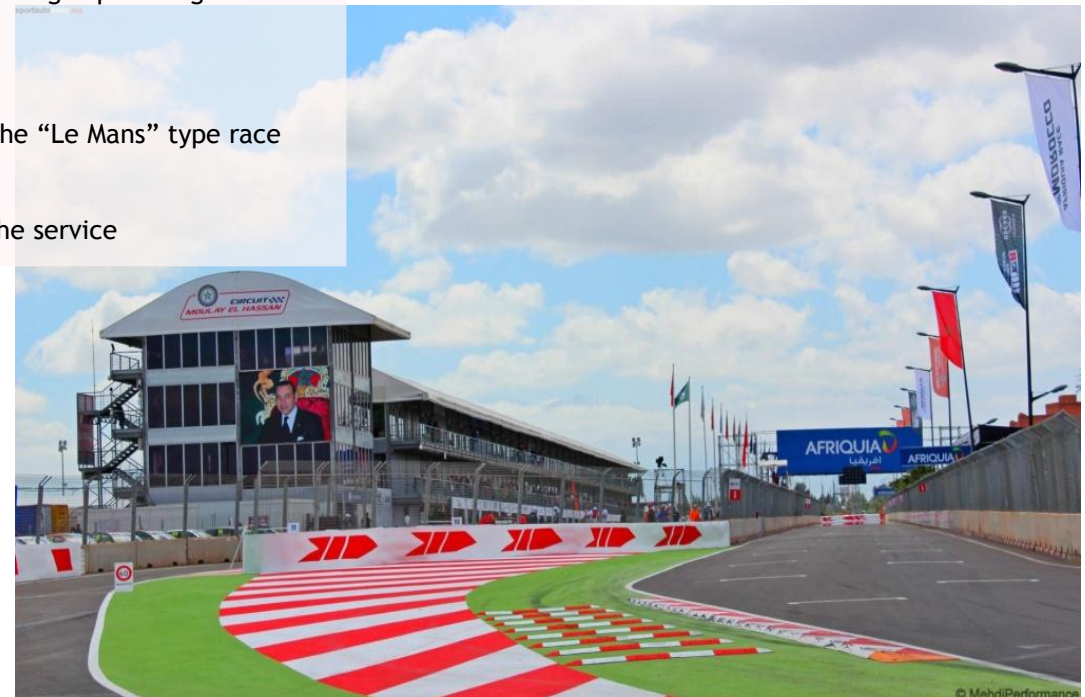
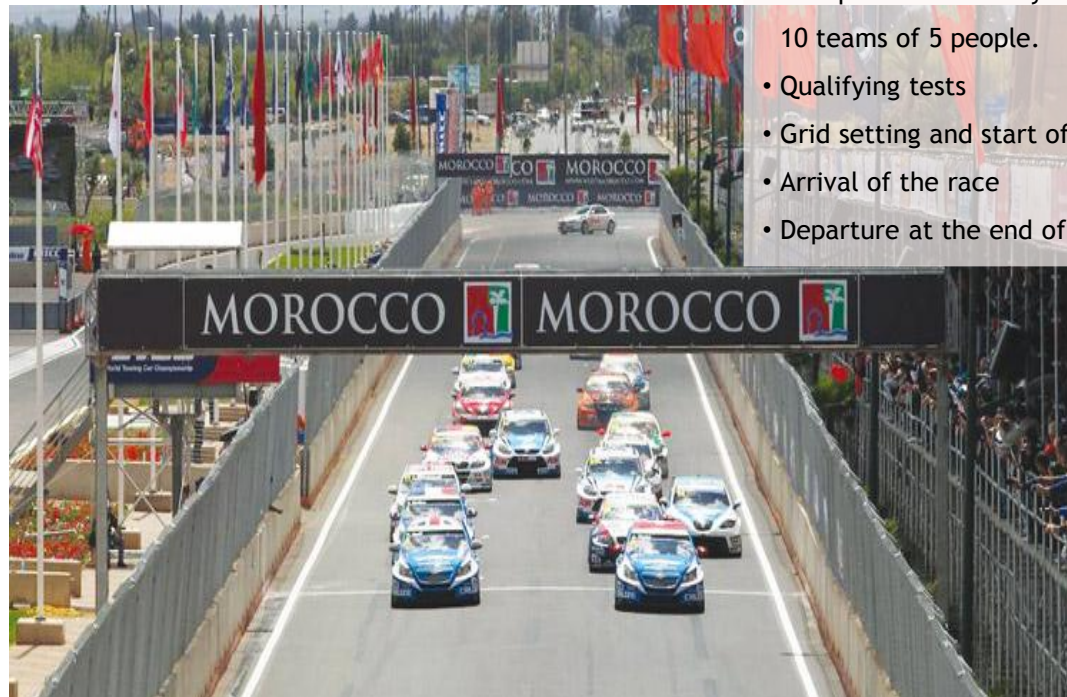


MARRAKECH GRAND PRIX

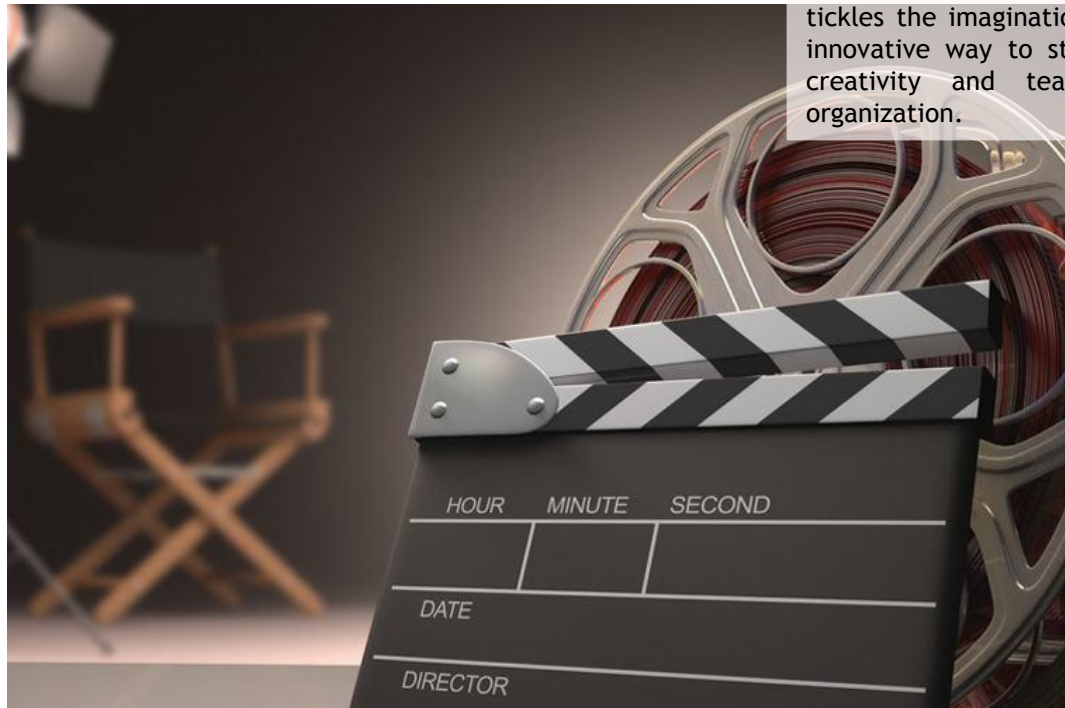

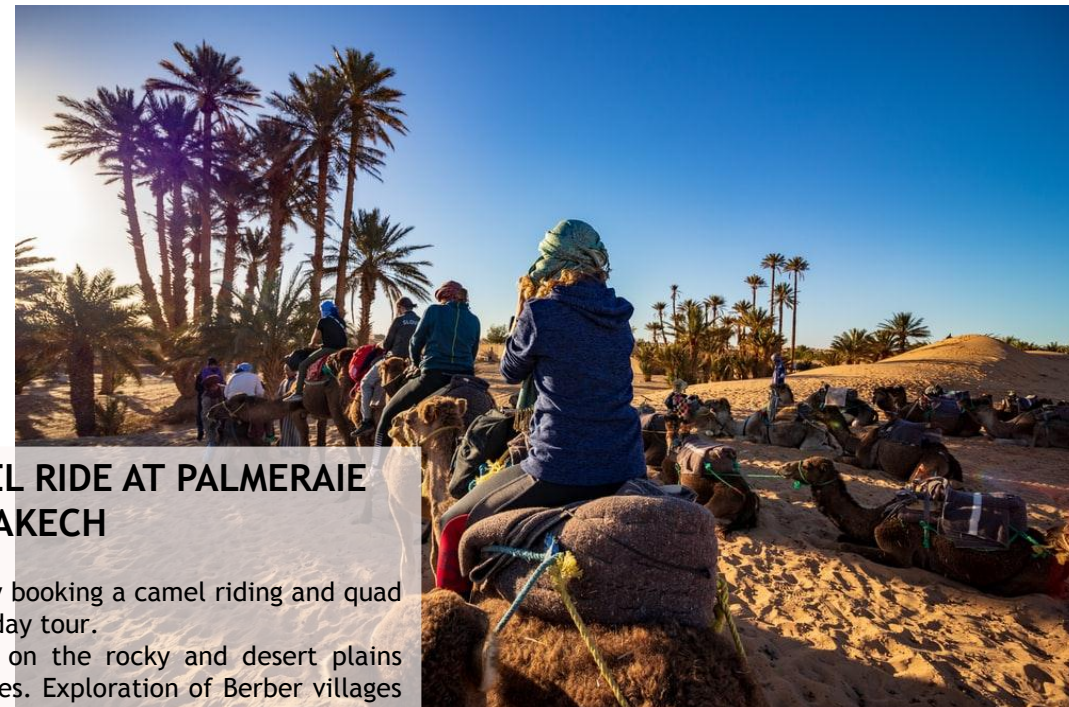
Enliven your stay in Marrakech by booking a camel riding and quad biking in the same day on a half day tour.

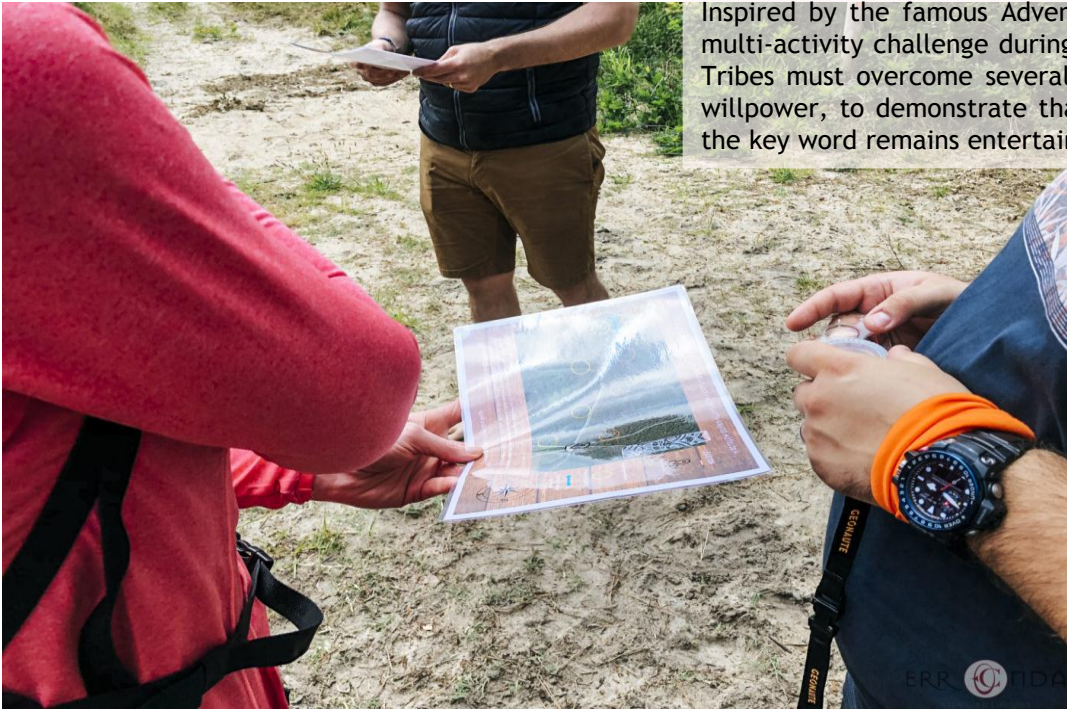

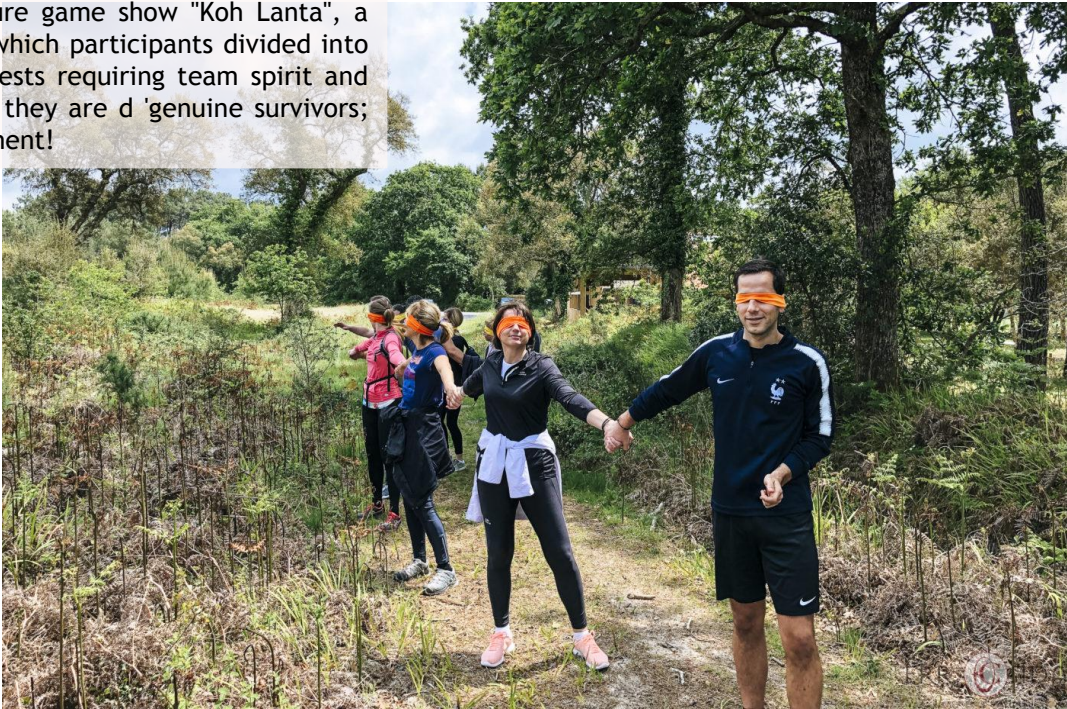


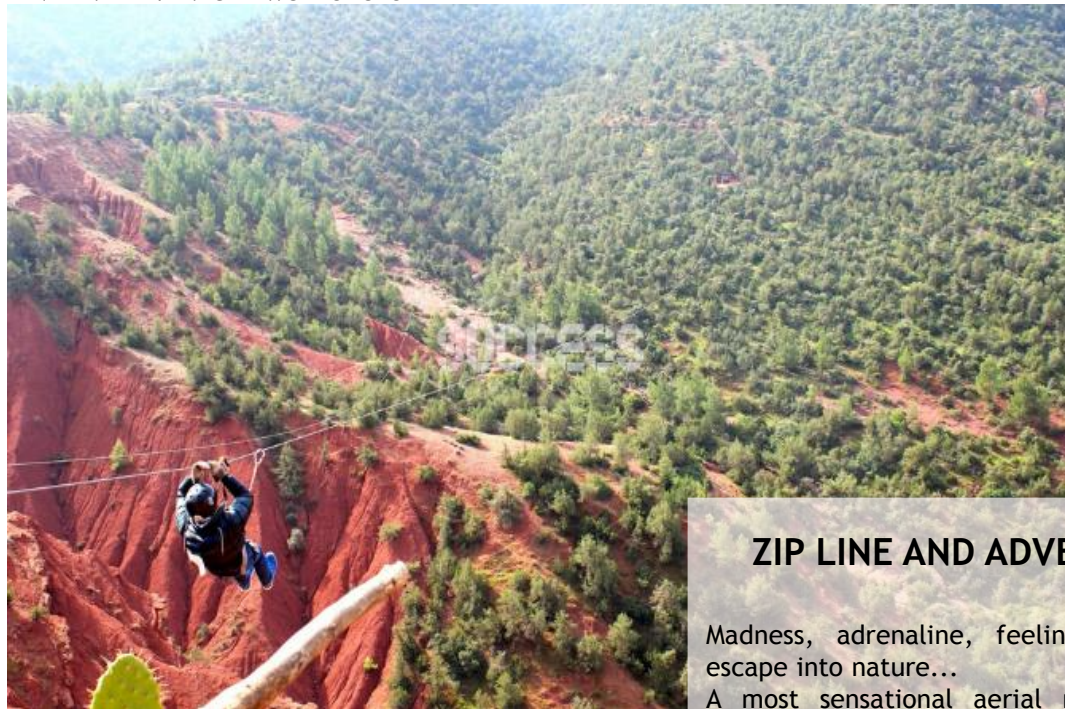


KOH LANTA ADVENTURE - SURVIVOR CHALLENGE

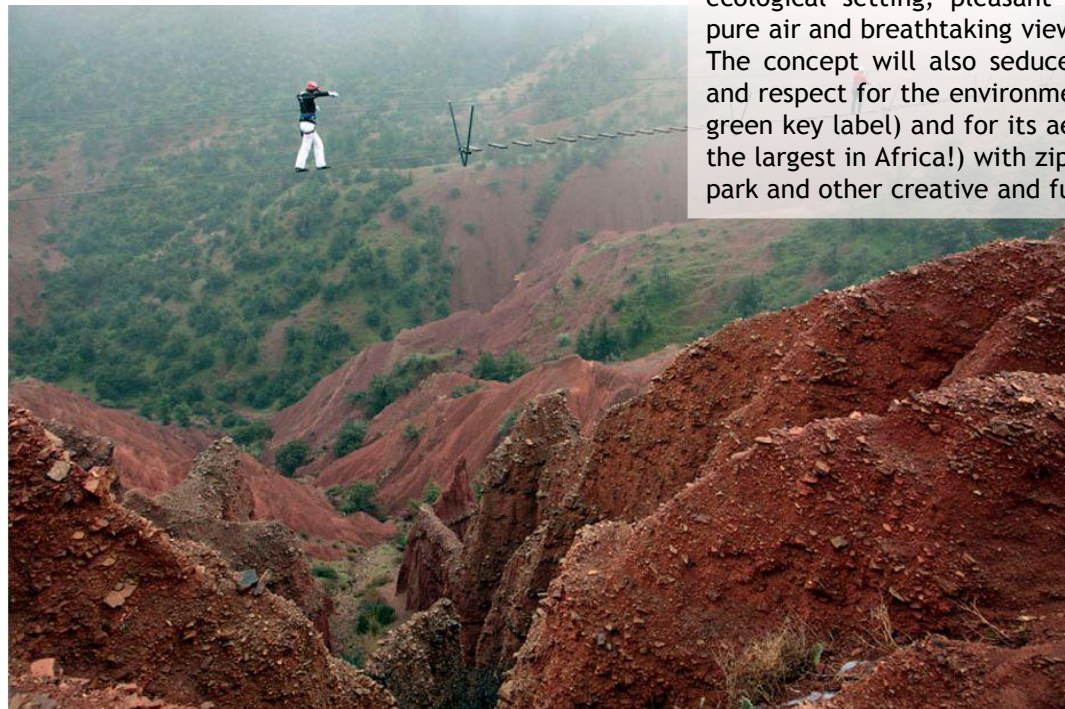

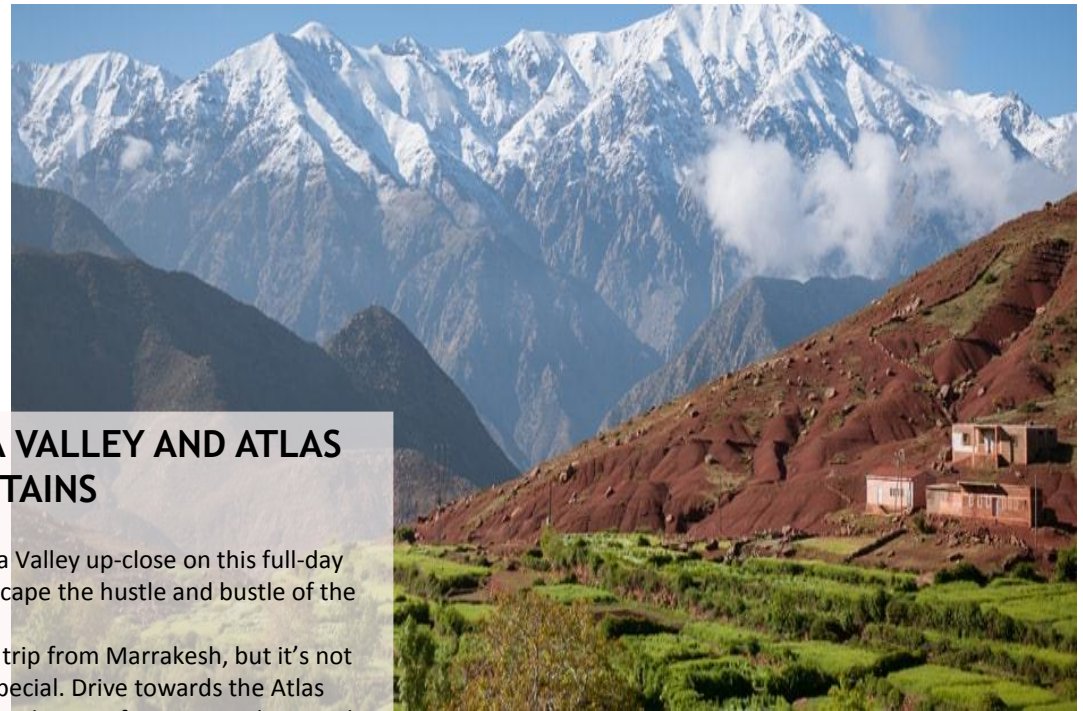
A most sensational aerial route, in a super natural and ecological setting, pleasant and highly invigorating with its pure air and breathtaking views of the High Atlas mountains.

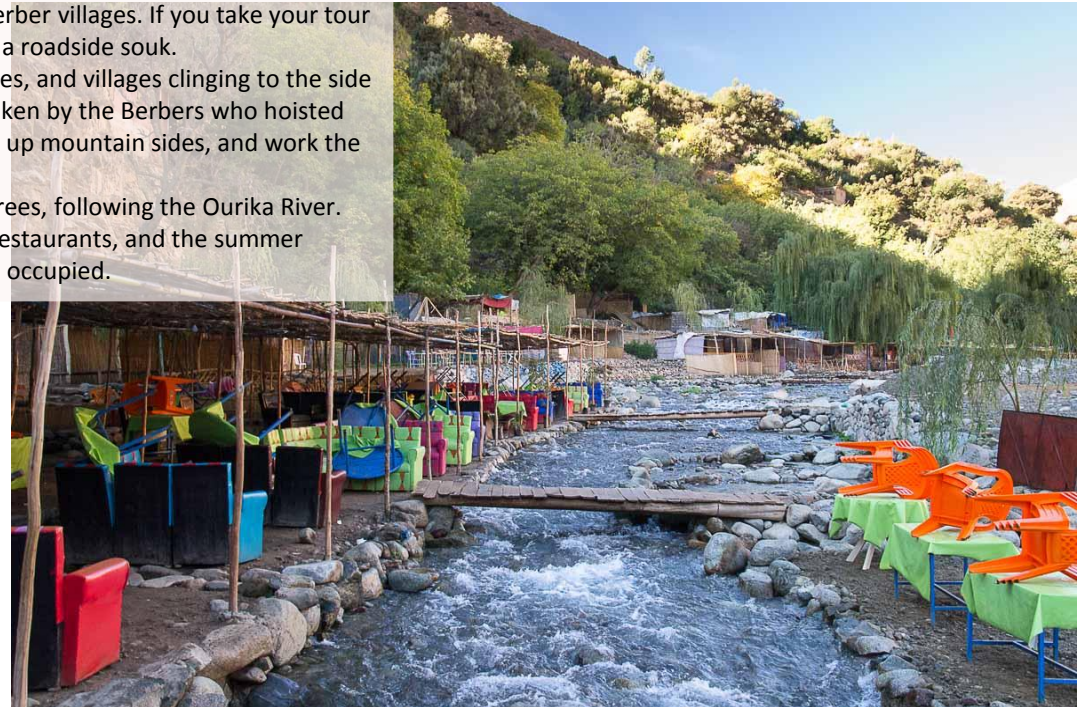
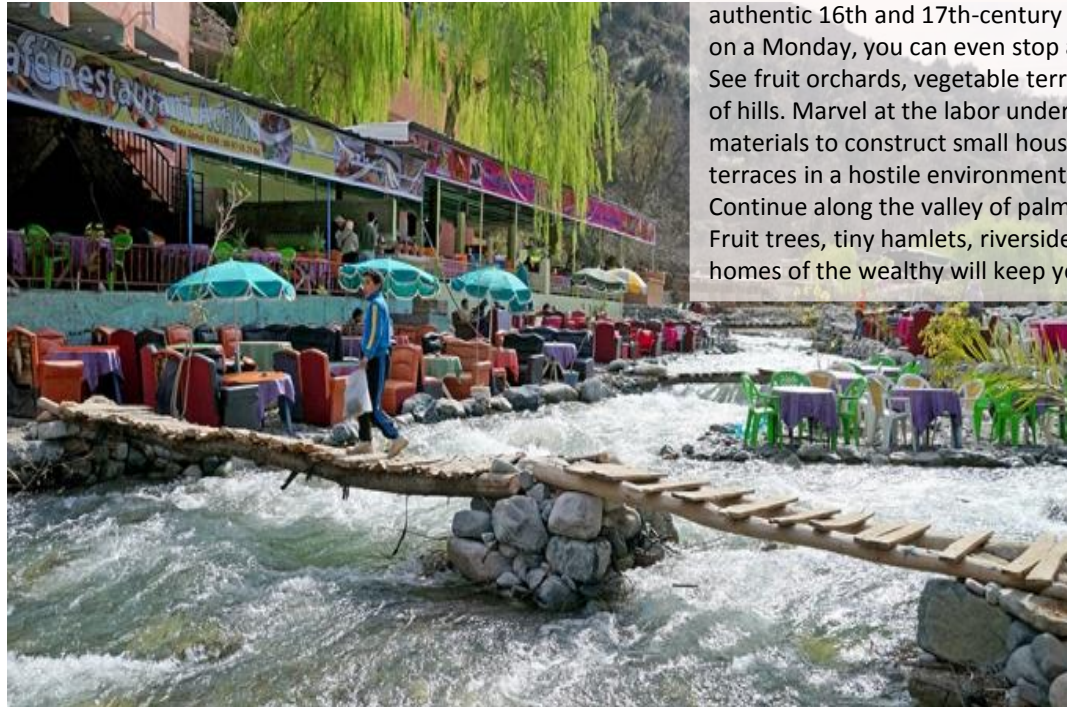
DAY TRIP TO OURIKA VALLEY AND ATLAS MOUNTAINS

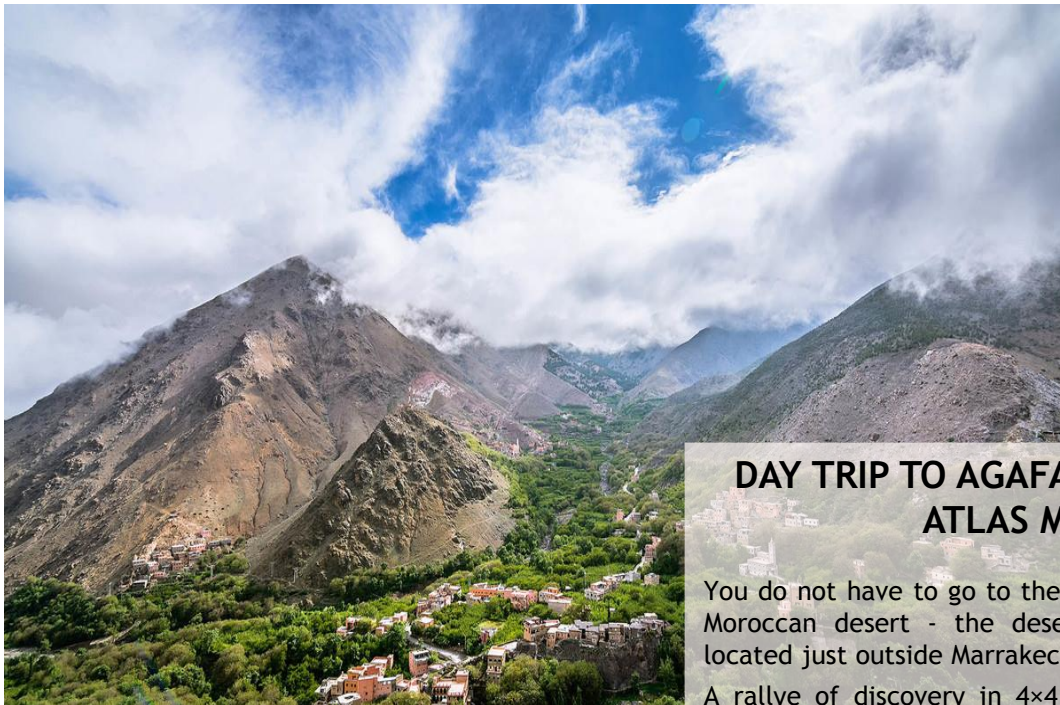
Experience the beauty of the Ourika Valley up-close on this full-day scenic tour from Marrakesh, and escape the hustle and bustle of the city for the day.

The Ourika Valley is the closest day trip from Marrakesh, but it's not just its convenience that makes it special. Drive towards the Atlas Mountains, taking in the beautiful landscape of green meadows and authentic 16th and 17th-century Berber villages. If you take your tour on a Monday, you can even stop at a roadside souk.

See fruit orchards, vegetable terraces, and villages clinging to the side of hills. Marvel at the labor undertaken by the Berbers who hoisted materials to construct small houses up mountain sides, and work the terraces in a hostile environment.

Continue along the valley of palm trees, following the Ourika River. Fruit trees, tiny hamlets, riverside restaurants, and the summer homes of the wealthy will keep you occupied.





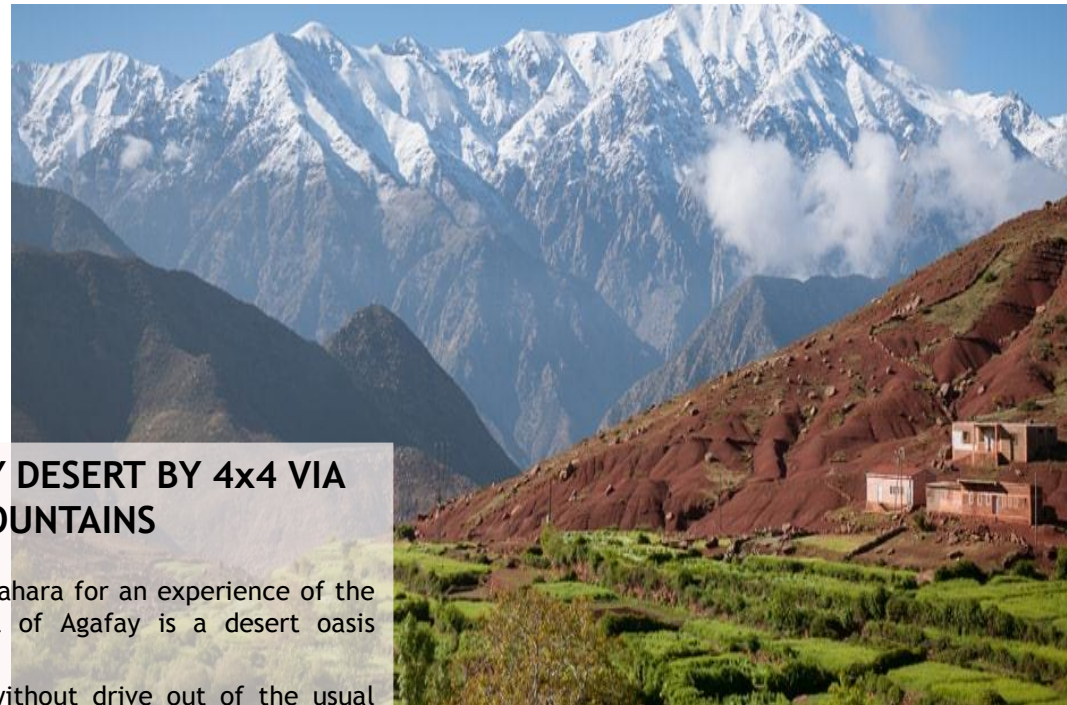
DAY TRIP TO AGAFAY DESERT BY 4x4 VIA ATLAS MOUNTAINS

Enjoy the time of a meal in the calm and serenity of the Agafay desert by enjoying a lunch cooked using fresh products.



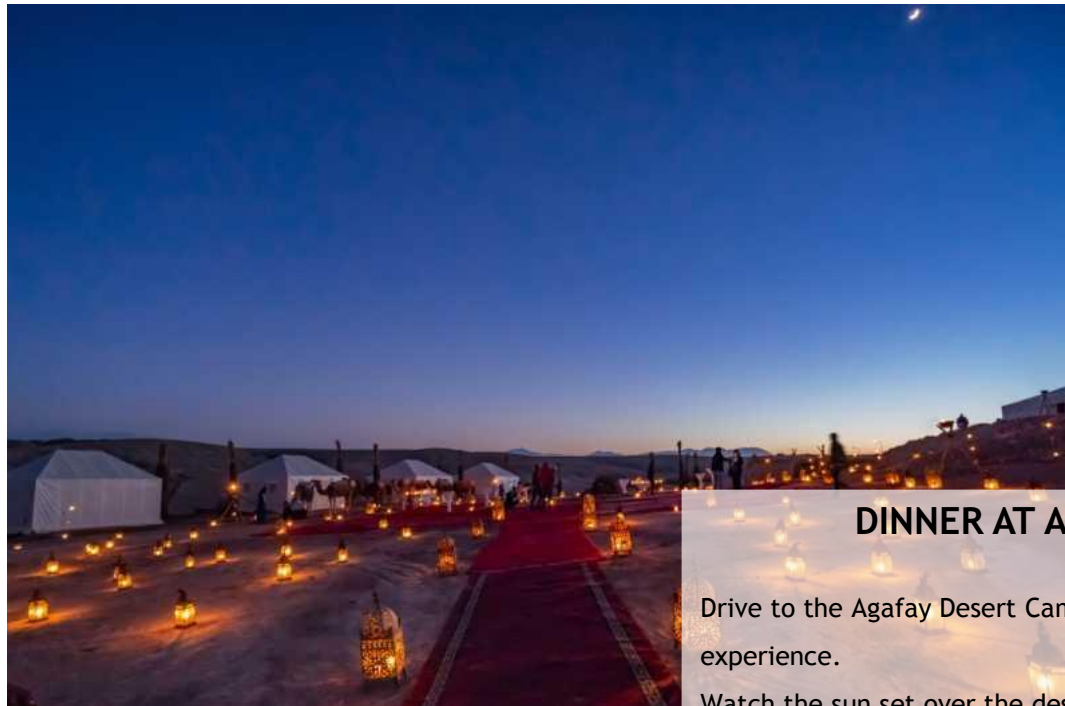


CAMEL & QUAD RIDE IN AGAFAY DESERT

Ride across the desert on your camel or Quad ,find a vantage point to enjoy the unique beauty of sunset in the Agafay Desert.





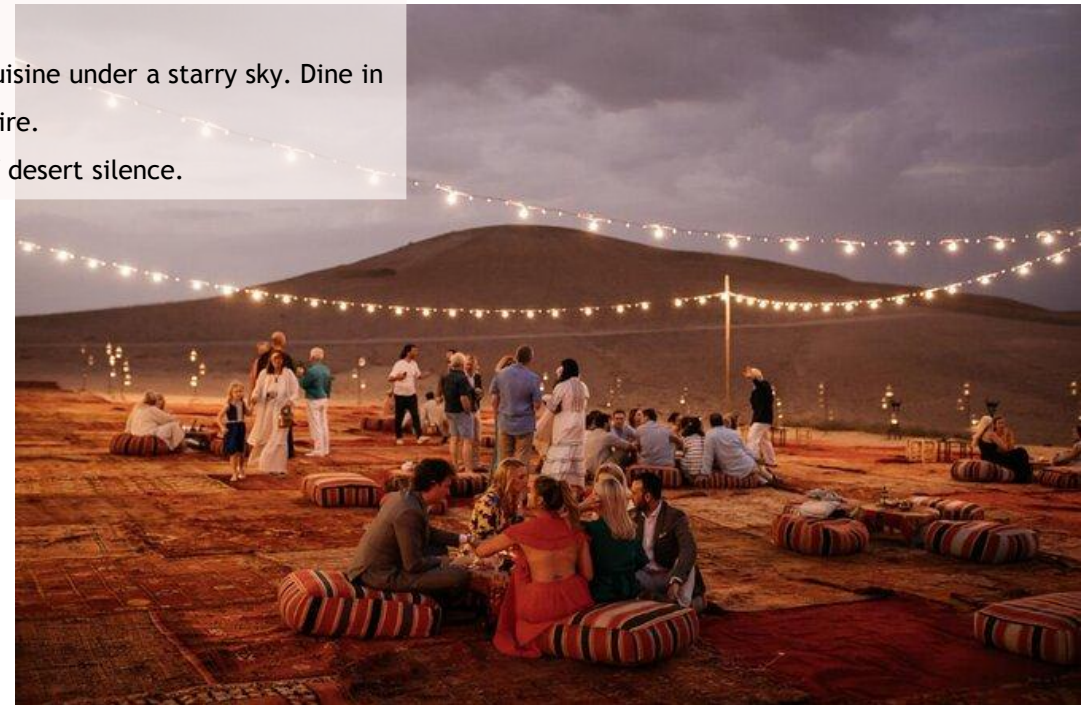
DINNER AT AGAFAY DESERT

A bustling weekly market takes place every Monday in this village, attracting people from all over the surrounding area.

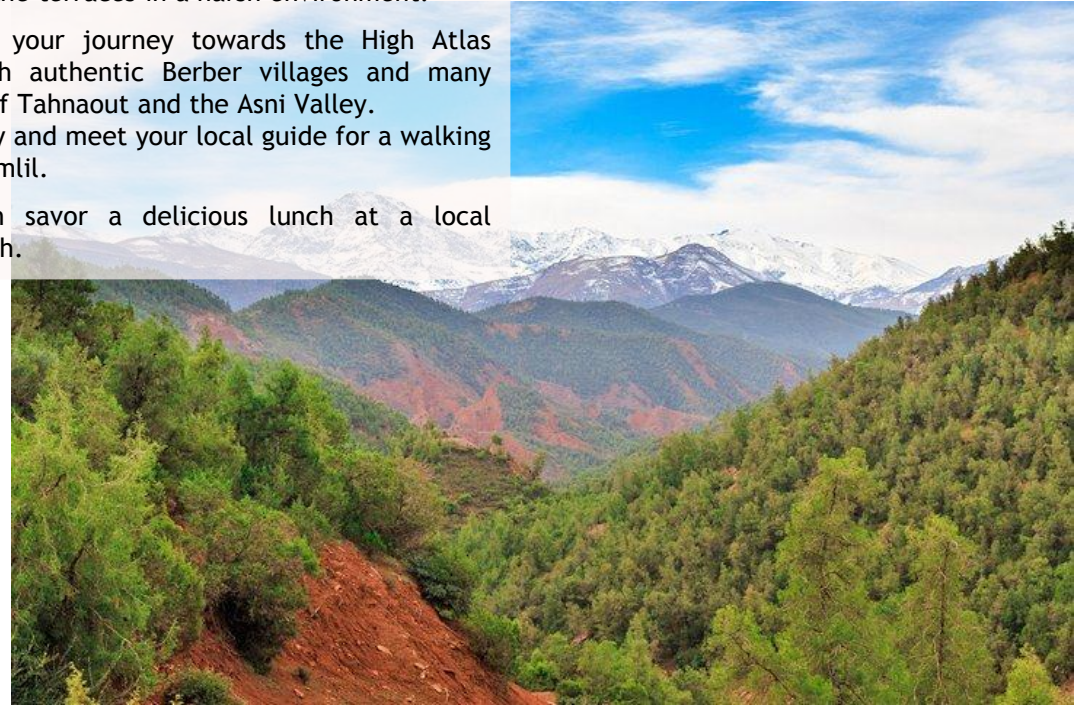
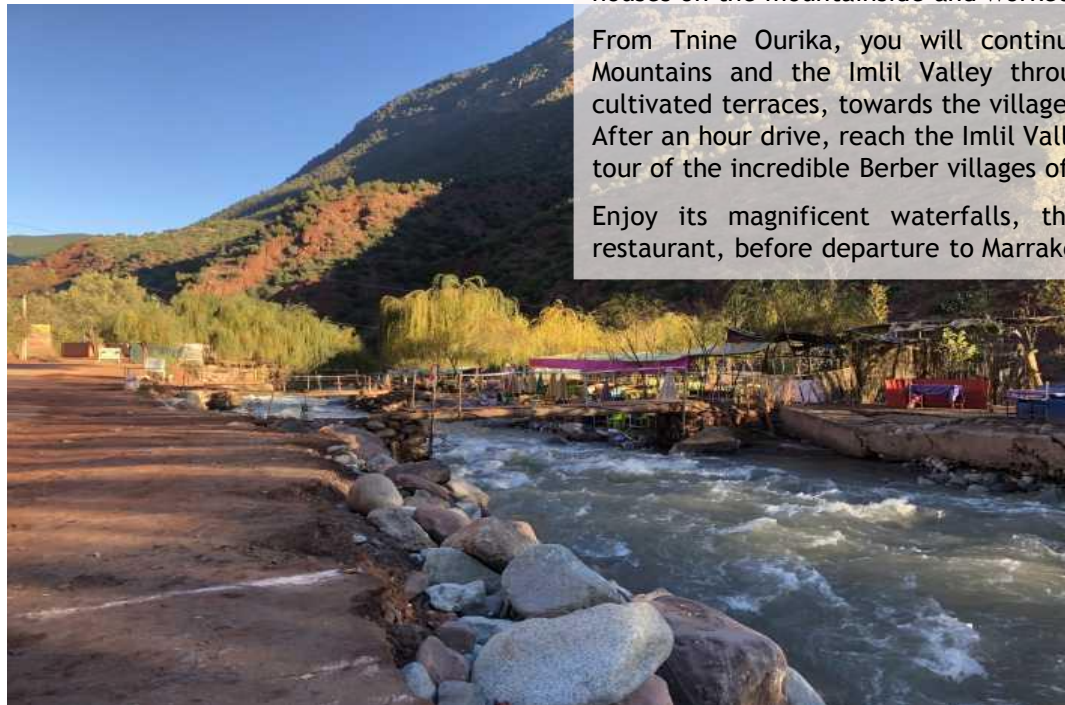
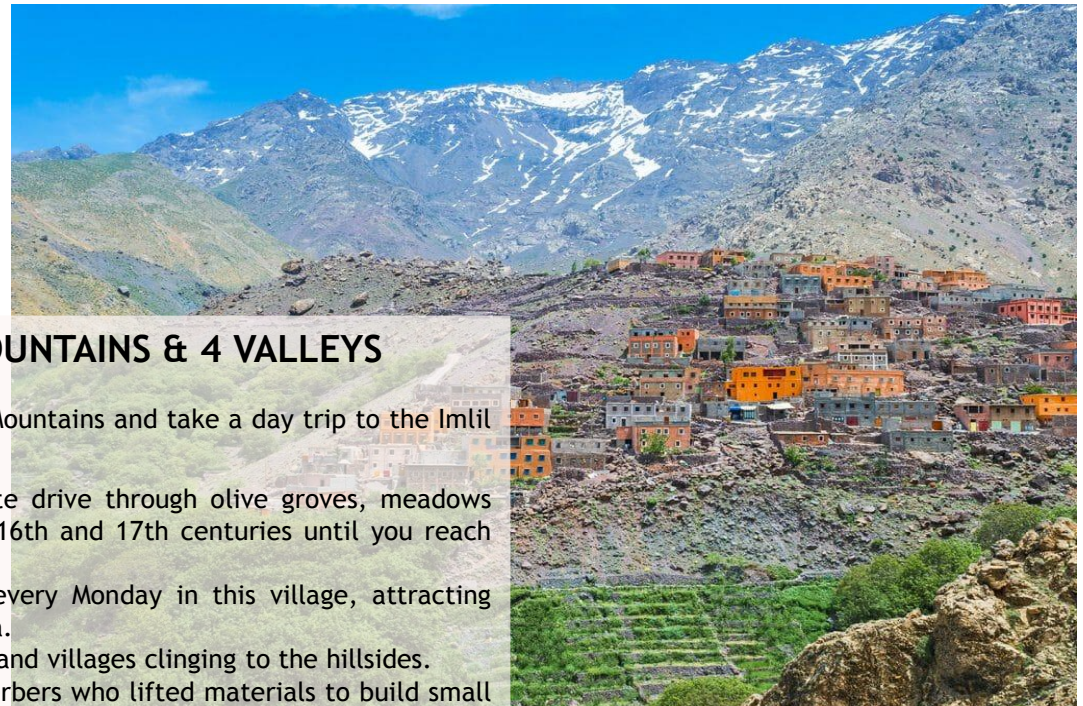
Admire the orchards, vegetable terraces and villages clinging to the hillsides.

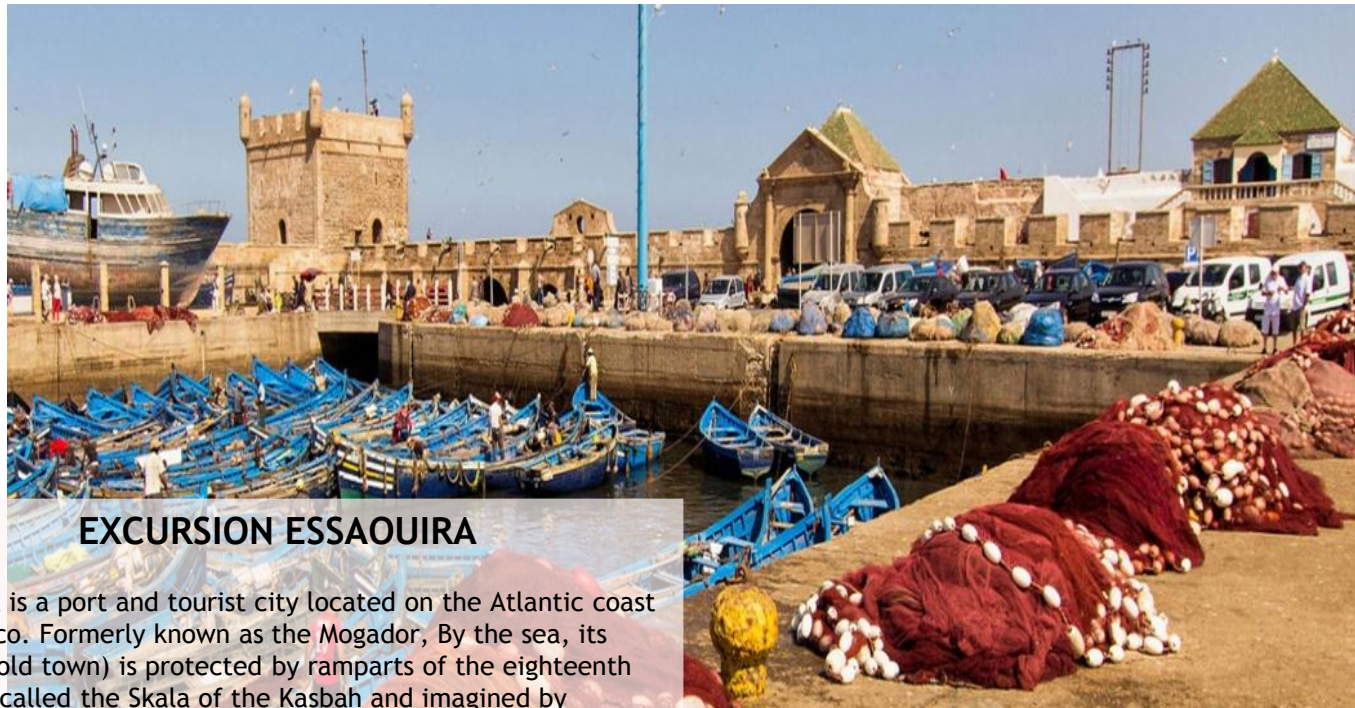
Marvel at the work undertaken by the Berbers who lifted materials to build small houses on the mountainside and worked the terraces in a harsh environment.

After an hour drive, reach the Imlil Valley and meet your local guide for a walking tour of the incredible Berber villages of Imlil.

Enjoy its magnificent waterfalls, then savor a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, before departure to Marrakech.

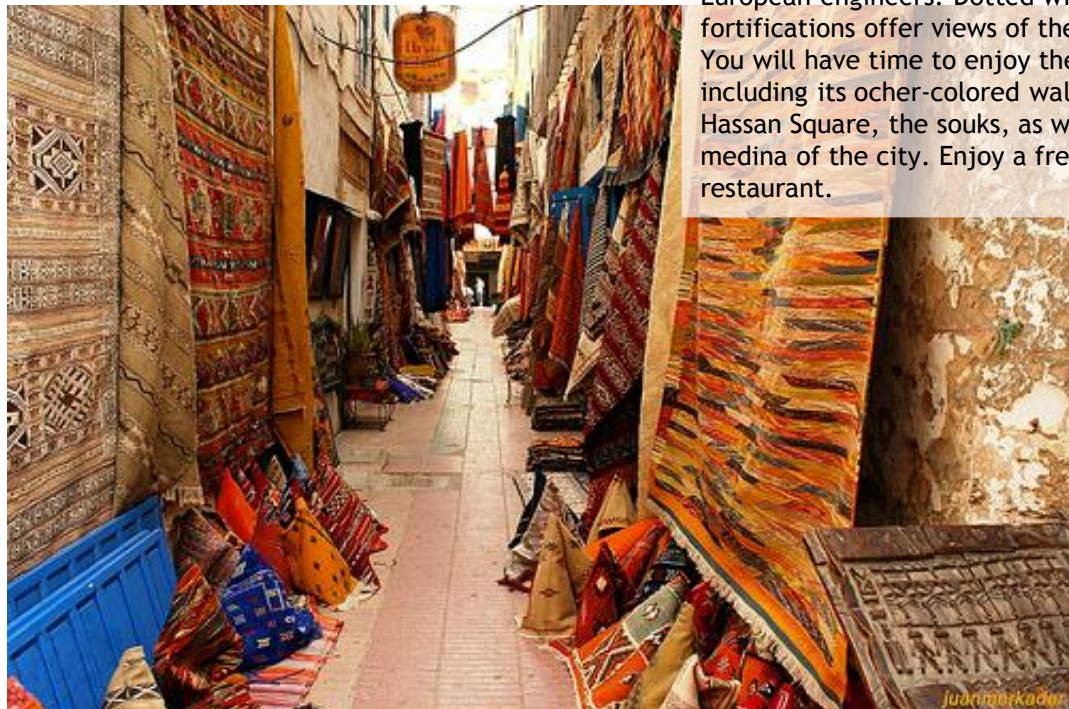





EXCURSION ESSAOUIRA

Essaouira is a port and tourist city located on the Atlantic coast of Morocco. Formerly known as the Mogador, By the sea, its medina (old town) is protected by ramparts of the eighteenth century, called the Skala of the Kasbah and imagined by European engineers. Dotted with ancient copper guns, the fortifications offer views of the ocean.

You will have time to enjoy the charming views of Essaouira, including its ocher-colored walls, the beautiful Moulay El Hassan Square, the souks, as well as the small streets of the old medina of the city. Enjoy a fresh fish lunch at a local restaurant.





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
