
Day 1 - Porto

Reception at the airport.

Transfer to the hotel and check in.

Rest of the day at leisure.

Day 2 - Porto

Breakfast at the hotel.

Full Day Tour Porto.

Porto is the second biggest city of Portugal and with unique beauty. Known for the Porto Wine and the river Douro, this is a vibrant city, with an enormous cultural and artistic life, where in every corner there is something amazing to see and experience.

Places not to be missed: the historical center that is an UNESCO Heritage Site, Ribeira area (an neighborhood near the river, which is creates part of the beautiful landscape of Porto), Clérigos Tower (this icon of the city was created in the XVIII century), the Cathedral (XVIII cent.), Bolsa Palace, and of course the Port Wine Cellars.







Day 3 – Porto / Guimarães / Braga / Porto

Breakfast at the hotel.

Full day tour to visit two important cities of Portugal, full of history and culture. First, Guimarães the birth place of Portugal, here we are going to see the imposing Castle, the Palace of the Dukes of Bragança and visit the center to find a maze of beautiful streets and small squares that embrace us.

After lunch, proceed to Braga a city with more than 2000 years of history, which was founded by the Emperor Augustus Caesar. The main points are the Cathedral, Bom Jesus do Monte Sanctuary and the Republica Square in the center. (Optional)

Trip back to Porto.





Day 4 - Porto / Coimbra

Breakfast at the hotel and check out.

Transfer to Coimbra.

Coimbra is known for being the home of the first University of Portugal, one of the oldest in Europe, and also a UNESCO World Heritage site.

This ancient city, which exists since the Roman era, is full of history and life, which gives it a unique charm.

Here we will visit the Old Cathedral, the historical center with the Santa Cruz Church and the Barbaca Door and the University of Coimbra.

Day 5 – Coimbra / Fátima / Nazaré / Óbidos / Lisbon

Breakfast at the hotel and check out, Transfer to Fátima.

We start the day with Fatima the main religious site in Portugal, where we will find an imposing Sanctuary that receives thousands of visitors every year. Next, the fishing town of Nazaré, to visit the church of Our Lady of Nazaré that has an amazing view to the beach. Here we can find fresh and tasteful fish and seafood for lunch. After we follow the coast until Obidos, to visit the picturesque streets, Castle, churches and taste the typical liquor "ginginha". Then back on the road, towards Lisbon, arriving at the hotel and checking in.

Day 6 - Lisbon / Sintra / Cascais / Estoril / Lisbon

Breakfast at the hotel.

Sintra is a magical place near Lisbon, which is worth visiting at least once in your life.

Visit to the Pena National Palace, the most iconic monument of Sintra, built in one of the highest points in the region surrounded by a natural park of untold beauty. In the center of Sintra we will find the National Palace of Sintra, located right in the middle of the village, where we can also have lunch.

Followed by a visit to the Cabo da Roca Lighthouse, situated in the most western point of Europe and then the gorgeous city of Cascais considered the French Riviera of Portugal. Trip back to Lisbon.





Day 7 - Lisbon

Breakfast at the hotel.

Full day tour to visit Belém another mandatory stop in Lisbon due to its rich heritage. Here you can see the Ajuda National Palace, one of the largest palaces of Lisbon, the National Coach Museum, then the ex-libris, the Jerónimos Monastery, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Belém Tower symbol of the Portuguese Discoveries and before leaving Belém you have to taste the delicious and traditional pastries, Pastel de Belém.

In the evening dinner in a traditional restaurant with a Fado show.





Day 8 - Lisbon

Breakfast at the hotel.

Day at leisure to explore Lisbon.

This is a friendly and welcoming city, with history and stories in every corner.

Places not to be missed: downtown, where you can visit, the Terreiro do Paço Square, Lisbon's Cathedral and the Castle of São Jorge where you will find one of the best views of Lisbon. Here you can also visit Alfama, Chiado and Bairro Alto, typical neighborhoods.
